NEW TYRE AND WHEEL PACKAGE LAUNCHED

Snap-on, the brand leader in garage equipment for the automotive industry, has launched into its John Bean range a pair of products that are ideal for workshops looking to expand into wheel service.

The Boxer BB4100 digital display wheel balancer and BB2200 tilt back tyre changer offer innovative features and a wide range of benefits to users while also providing excellent value for money and an attractive route to delivering further services to their customers.

A 1D SAPE (semi-automatic parameter entry) for input of wheel offset and the ability to hide weights behind spokes for a better-looking finish are just two of the elements that make the BB4100 such a suitable choice, especially for independent garages and workshops.

With its automatic motor spin operation when the hood is closed, an eight-second cycle time and a rim width range of three to 15 inches, the BB4100 is designed for cars, light trucks and motorcycles (adaptors needed for some wheels).

Complementing the BB4100 is the BB2200 tyre changer, which is also ideal for independent garages and workshops wanting to move into tyre changing.

The single-speed BB2200 comes as standard with a pneumatic assist arm and has a tilt back column, along with a traditional steel mounting/demounting tool and plastic insert, while it has an outer clamping range of ten to 20 inches and can deal with wheels with a maximum diameter of 79 inches.

As with the BB4100, the BB2200 is designed for cars, light trucks and motorcycles (adaptors needed for some wheels). Additional optional accessories are a quick exchange device with plastic head and a set of four motorcycle wheel adaptors.
