This is normally a repeat for a complete side and will consist of multiple instructions.

**()** Repeat instructions between parentheses the amount of times specified.

This is a lower level repeat.

### Special Stitches

**Folding Sc:** Insert hook into back loop of next tr and into back loop of corresponding stitch in previous round, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through two loops.

**Picot:** Chain 3, sl-st through top of st to join.

**Popcorn:** Make 5 dc in same st, remove hook from loop and insert from front to back of 1st dc and then into dropped loop and pull through. Ch 1 to close. This closing chain is not counted in any chains you are asked to make after the popcorn.

To make a **Starting Popcorn**, simply start with a standing dc or ch 3 as your 1st st.

**Tr Cluster:** Yarn over twice, place hook in stitch or space to be worked and pull up a loop, 4 loops on hook, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice, 2 loops on hook.

Yarn over twice, place hook in same st/sp, pull up a loop, 5 loops on hook, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice, 3 loops on hook.

Yarn over twice, place hook in same st/sp, pull up a loop, 6 loops on hook, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice, 4 loops on hook.

Yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

To make a starting tr cluster, simply start with a standing tr or ch 4 as your 1st st.

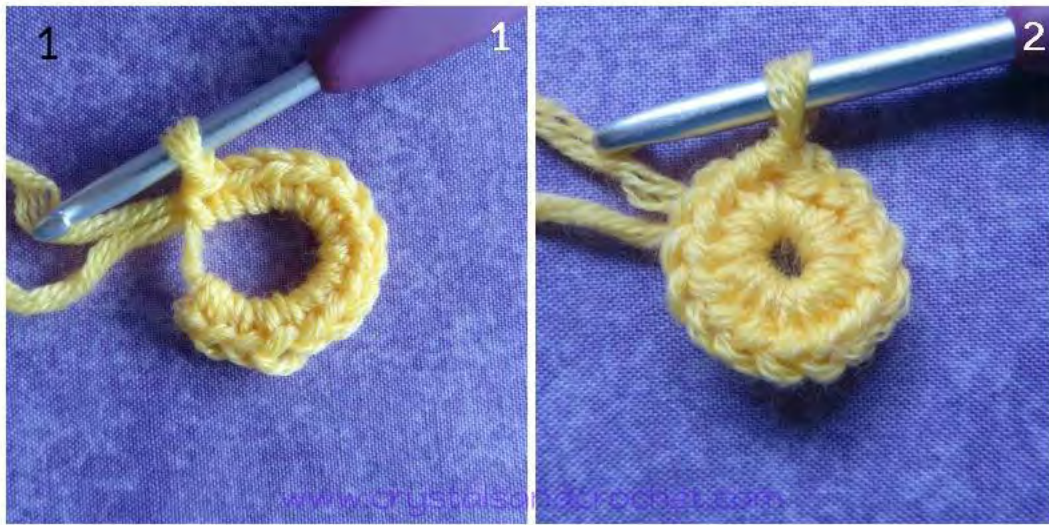

1. Starting with a magic ring, make 16 sc into ring.  
Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st, and pull up ring.  
Stitch Count: 16 sc.



2. Ch 3 [*counts as dc*] dc in same st, (ch 2 skip next st, 2 dc in next st) 7 more times, ch 2.  
Join to top of ch 3, fasten off, and secure ends.  
Stitch Count: 16 dc, 8 ch 2 spaces.





*Hint: To learn how to form a Perfect Picot go to tutorials on my website.*

3. Working in front of Round 2 and ONLY into skipped stitches in Round 1, make a standing sc, ch 3 and sl-st through sc to form a picot [P1,2,3]

\*sc in next skipped st, ch 3, sl-st into sc to form a picot.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 6 more times.

Join to standing sc, fasten off, pull ends through to back of work and secure.

Stitch Count: 8 sc with picot.



4. Make a starting popcorn in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc of any pair from [R2],

\*ch 3, skip ch 2 space, skip next st, make a popcorn in next st.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 6 more times, ch 3.

Join to beginning popcorn, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 8 popcorn, 8 ch 3 spaces.





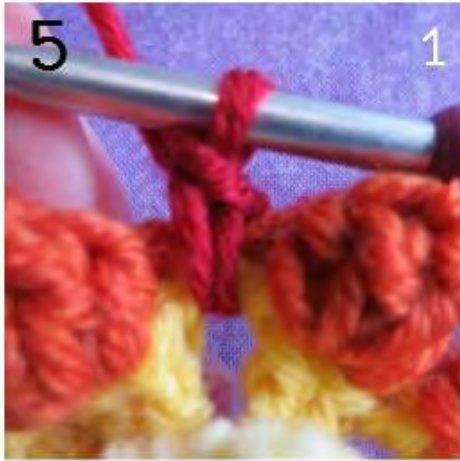
5. Join with a standing sc in any ch-2 space from [R2] also working over ch-3 from [R4],

\*in next ch-2 space make 7 tr, [*making sure the popcorn is in front of your stitches and that you are working over both chains*], [P2,3]  
sc in next ch 2 space.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 3 more times, omit last sc.

Join to standing sc, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 4 sc, 4 shells of 7 tr.



6. Join in any sc with a standing tr, make 4 more tr in same st, ch 3 and sl-st into top of tr to form a picot [P3], make 4 more tr in same st,  
 \*ch 2, sl-st into base of [R5] shell at back of your work [P5], ch 2,  
 in next sc, (5tr, ch 3 picot, 4tr).\*

Repeat from \* to \* twice more, ch 2, sl-st into base of [R5] shell, ch 2.  
 Join to standing tr, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 4 point groups of 9 tr with picot [36 tr in total], 8 ch-2 spaces.





7. Join with a standing sc in the bl of 7<sup>th</sup> tr of any group,  
 \*blhdc in next st [*8<sup>th</sup> tr*], bldc in next st [*9<sup>th</sup> tr*], 3 tr in ch-2 space, skip sl-st,  
 3 tr in next ch-2 space, bldc in next st [*1<sup>st</sup> tr*], blhdc in next st [*2<sup>nd</sup> tr*], blsc in next st [*3<sup>d</sup> tr*],  
 ch 3, skip next 3 sts, blsc in next st [*7<sup>th</sup> tr*].\*  
 Repeat from \* to \* 3 more times, omit last blsc.  
 Join to standing sc with a sl-st.  
 Stitch Count: 8 blsc, 8 blhdc, 8 bldc, 24 tr, 4 ch-3 spaces.



8. Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next st,  
 \*(2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 3 times, sc in next st, ch 3, skip ch-3, sc in next 2 sts.\*  
 Repeat from \* to \* 3 more times, omit last 2 sc.  
 Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, fasten off and secure ends.  
 Stitch Count: 60 sc, 4 ch-3 spaces.





9. Join with a standing fltr in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of any group, fltr in next 14 sts, \*ch 1, sc over both chains [R7 and R8], ch 1, fltr in next 15 sts.\* Repeat from \* to \* twice more, ch 1, sc over both chains, ch 1, **DO NOT JOIN**.  
Stitch Count: 4 sc, 60 fltr, 8 ch 1 spaces.



10. \*Make a folding sc [*see special stitches*] in next 15 tr, skip ch-1 space, sc in sc, skip ch-1 space.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 3 more times.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> fsc, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 60 folding sc, 4 sc.





11. Make a standing sc in any sc which falls between folding sc groups, sc in picot [R6], sc in same sc [R10], [P2]

\*sc in next 15 fsc, sc in next sc, sc in picot, sc in same sc.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 3 more times, omit last sc/picot group/sc .

Join to standing sc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 72 sc.



12. *Hint: ch-4 tr groups fall into the sc made into picot and stitch above 8<sup>th</sup> fsc, giving 8 in total.*

Starting in sc made into picot \*(sl-st, ch 4, tr, ch 4, sl-st ) into sc made into picot, sc in next 8 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sl-st, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 64 sc, 8 tr, 16 ch-4.



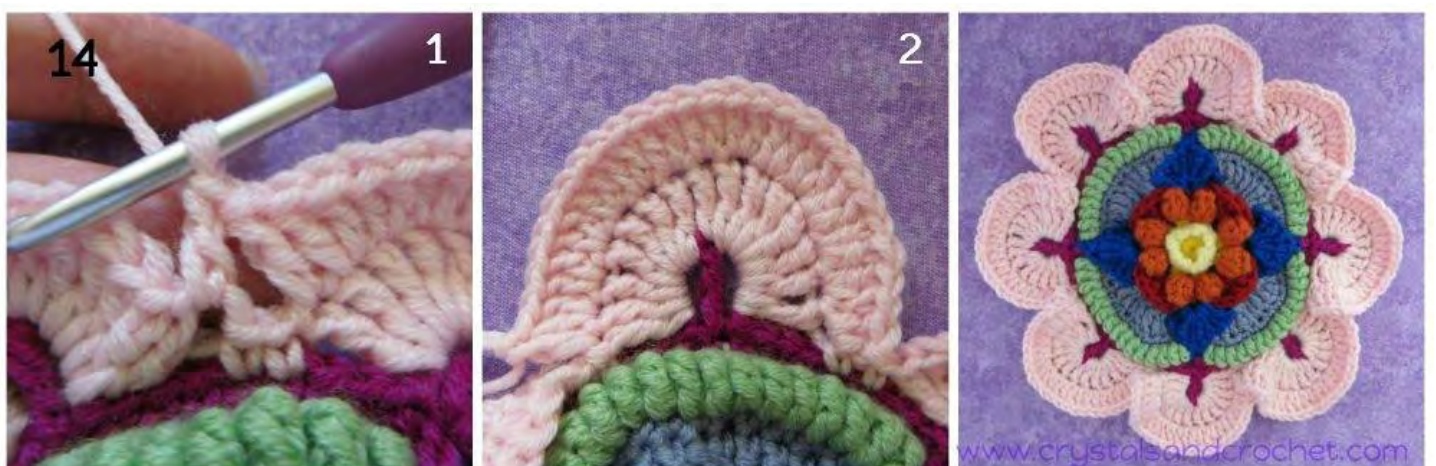


13. Join with a standing sc in 5<sup>th</sup> sc after any tr/ch loop,  
 \*skip next 3 sts, in ch-4 loop make 7 tr, tr in tr, make 7 tr in next ch-4 loop, skip next 3 sts,  
 sc in next 2 sts\*.  
 Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last sc.  
 Join to standing sc with a sl-st.  
 Stitch Count: 16 sc, 120 tr.



14. \*Skip sc's, dc in 1<sup>st</sup> tr of next group, 2 dc in next 13 sts, dc in last tr.\*  
 Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times.  
 Join to 1<sup>st</sup> dc, fasten off and secure ends.  
 Stitch Count: 224 dc.

*Hint: your work will be very wobbly at this point, but will lay flat again after the next few rounds.*





15. Join with a **bpsc** in any dc, **bpsc** in each dc around.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> bpsc, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 224 bpsc.



*Hint: Work away all ends, I suggest working [R15] ends into [R12] to make it easier to work the sts of [R15] in the next part.*

### Special Stitches

**Folding Sc:** Insert hook into back loop of next tr and into back loop of corresponding stitch in previous round, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through two loops.

**Beginning Tr Cluster:** Chain 3, yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch or space, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch or space, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

**Tr Cluster:** Yarn over twice, insert hook into indicated stitch or space, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch or space, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch or space, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (4 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

16. Join with a standing sc in 24<sup>th</sup> bpsc [5<sup>th</sup> from end] of any group, sc in next st, \*sc in 4<sup>th</sup> bpsc of next group, sc in next st, ch 5, bpsc at top of central tr [R13] [P4], ch 5, sc in 24<sup>th</sup> bpsc, sc in next st.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 2 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 32 sc, 8 bpsc, 16 ch-5 spaces.



17. Ch 3 [counts as dc] or make a starting dc, dc in next 3 sts, \*in ch-5 space (2 hdc, 3 sc), skip bpsc, in next ch-5 space (3 sc, 2 hdc), dc in next 4 sts.\* Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 4 dc.

Join to top of ch-3 with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 48 sc, 32 hdc, 32 dc.





18. Sl-st into 3<sup>rd</sup> dc, make a (beginning tr cluster, ch 3, tr cluster, ch 3, tr cluster) all in same st [*3<sup>rd</sup> dc*], [*P2*]

\*ch 4, skip next 5 sts, sc in next 2 sts, ch 4, skip next 6 sts, in next st [*3<sup>rd</sup> dc*] (tr cluster, ch 3, tr cluster, ch 3, tr cluster).\*

Repeat from \* to \* 6 more times, ch 4, skip next 5 sts, sc in next 2 sts, ch4, skip next 6 sts.

Join to beginning tr cluster, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 16 sc, 24 tr cluster, 16 ch-3 spaces, 16 ch-4 spaces.





19. *Hint: In this round you will be working into sts from Rounds 15, 17 and 18, as it is quite wordy I have made the instructions into list form to make it easier to follow.*

Join with a standing sc through back loop of 14<sup>th</sup> bpsc [R15] and 1<sup>st</sup> sc of any pair of sc [R18], [P1,2]

\*skip next bpsc [R15] and make a sc through back loop of next bpsc [R15] and 2<sup>nd</sup> sc [R18],  
*working in front of ch-4* hdc in next 2 sts [R17],

dc in next 2 sts [R17],

sc in cluster [R18],

3 sc in ch-3 space ,

sc in next cluster, ch-1 [*forming point space*],

3 sc in next ch-3 space,

sc in cluster,

sc in next ch-4 space,

*working in front of the ch-4 and into* [R17],

skip 1<sup>st</sup> st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts,

sc through back loop of 14<sup>th</sup> bpsc from [R15] and 1<sup>st</sup> sc from [R18].\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 96 sc, 32 hdc, 32 dc.

*Hint: ch-1 point spaces are not included in any stitch counts.*





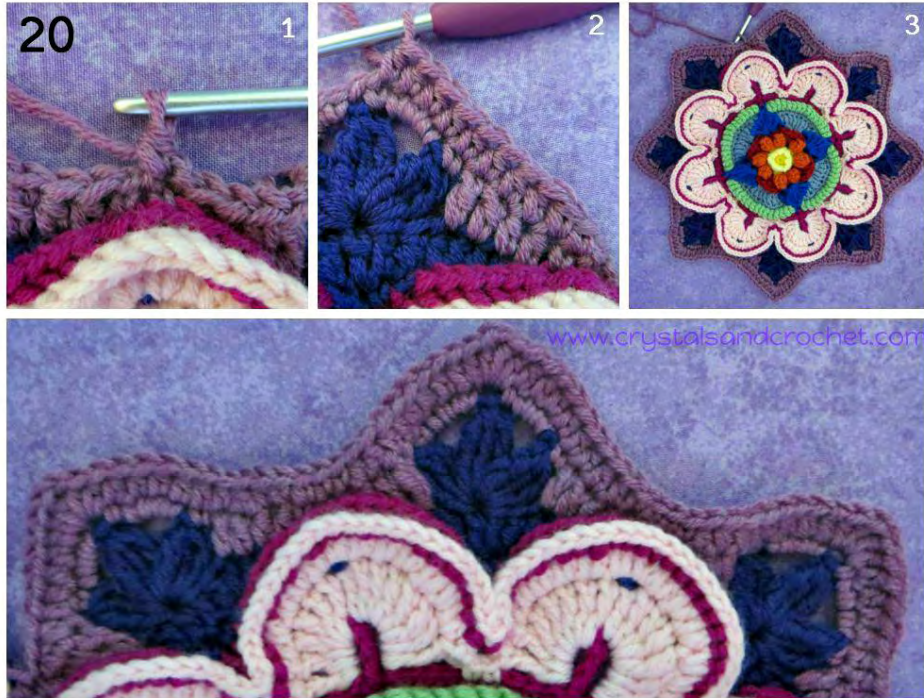
20. Ch 1 and sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts,

\*hdc in next 8 sts, in ch-1 point space (2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc), hdc in next 8 sts, *taking care not to miss the 1<sup>st</sup> st*, sc in next 4 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 3 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 32 sc, 160 hdc.

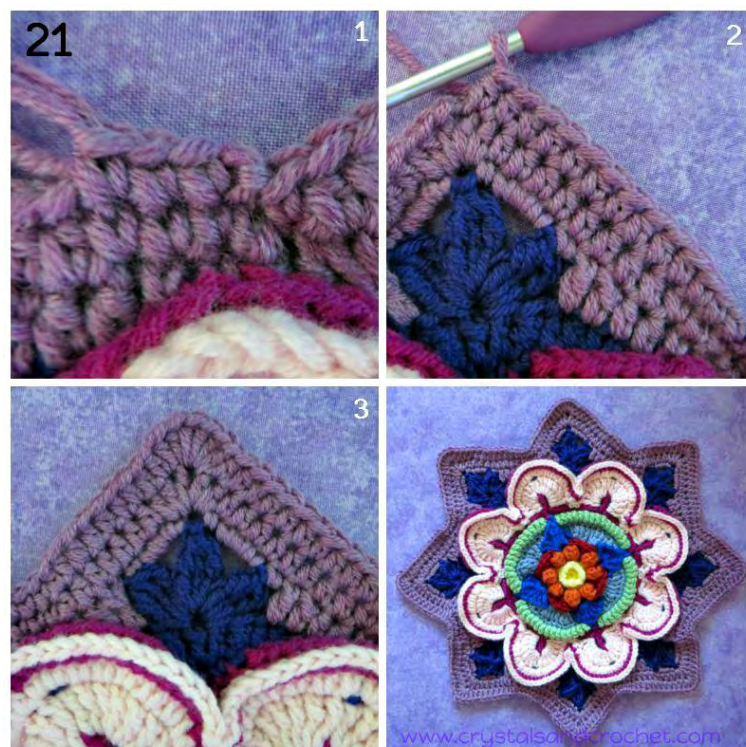


21. Ch 1 and sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, \*hdc in next 10 sts, 5 hdc in ch-1 point space, hdc in next 10 sts *taking care not to miss the 1<sup>st</sup> st*, sc in next 4 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 3 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 32 sc, 200 hdc.





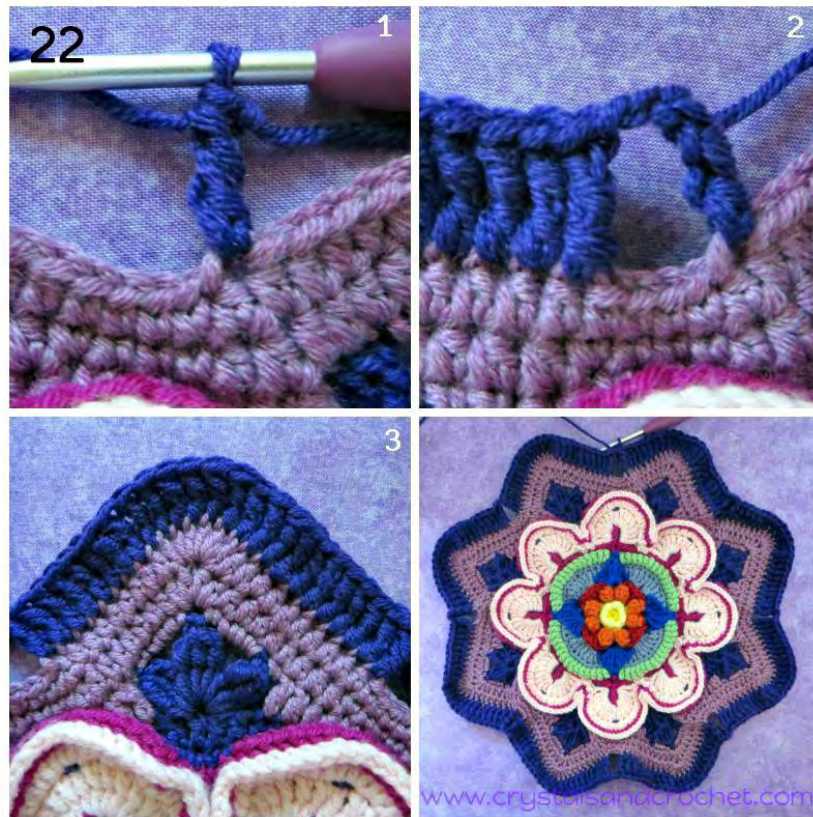
22. Join with a standing tr in front loop of last hdc in any group, [P1]

\*ch 2, skip next 4 sc[P2], fltr in next 25 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last fltr.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> fltr **front loop only** with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 200 fltr, 8 ch-2 spaces



23. Make a folding sc in the standing fltr, \*skip ch-2, make a folding sc in the next 25 fltr, [taking care that you are working into the free bl [R22] at the base of each st, especially around the point].\*

Repeat from \* to \*7 more times, omit last folding sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> folding sc, fasten off, and secure ends.

**Place a marker in 13<sup>th</sup> folding sc of each point.**

Stitch Count: 200 folding sc.

### Special Stitches

**Ruffle Stitch:** Made over 3 sts. Flsc in indicated stitch, and working around the front of the post of the same st, from top to bottom (hdc, 3 dc), skip next st, flsc in next st.

**Tr9tog Cluster:** Yarn over twice, hook through indicated stitch and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, twice, repeat in next 8 sts, giving 10 loops on hook, yarn over and pull through all 10 loops.

**Sc2tog:** Hook through indicated stitch and pull up a loop, repeat in next stitch, yarn over and pull through all three loops on hook.

Hint: In this round you will only be working into the folding sc, which sit behind your work. Refer to photo of Round 23.

24. Join with a standing hdc in any marked st, make 2 more hdc in same st,  
\*hdc in next 10 sts, sc2tog twice,  
[these will be 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> folding sc, and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> folding sc of next point]  
hdc in next 10 sts, 3 hdc in next st [marked st].\*

Repeat from \* to\* 7 more times, omit last 3 hdc.

Join to standing hdc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: 184 hdc, 16 sc2tog.



Hint: To learn more about working stitches together go to the tutorials section on my website.



*Hint: In this round you will be working with two colours and carrying one colour behind the other, as you switch colours give the new colour a gentle pull to ensure an even tension throughout your work.*

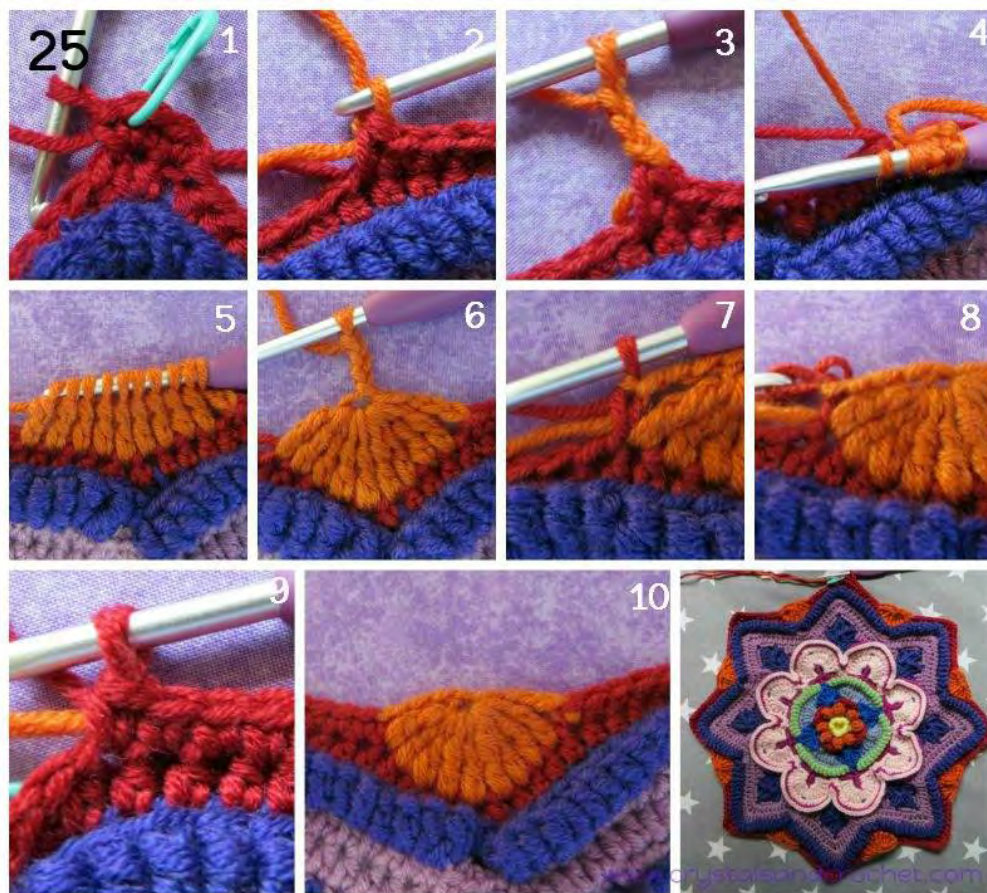
*You may find it helpful to use stitch markers in the ch-1 point spaces from this point forward, also remember ch-1 point spaces are not included in any stitch count.*

25. Ch 1 and sc in same st, \*in next st (sc, ch 1, sc) [*forming new point space*], sc in next 8 sts, add 2<sup>nd</sup> colour by completing last sc with 2<sup>nd</sup> colour [**P2**], ch 3, working over 1<sup>st</sup> colour, make a tr9tog cluster over the next 9 sts, ch 3, joining colour 1, and working over colour 2 [**P7**], sc in same st as last tr, sc in next 7 sts.\* Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 18 sc, 1 tr9tog cluster, 2 ch-3 spaces.

Total: 144 sc, 8 tr9tog clusters, 16 ch-3 spaces.



*Hint: Using a Tunisian hook makes working with large clusters easier, especially with thicker yarns.*





26. Ch 1 and sc in same st, [*making sure you are still working over colour 2*], sc in next st, \*in ch-1 point space (sc, ch 1, sc), sc in next 9 sts [*taking care not to miss the 1<sup>st</sup> st*], re-join colour 2 as you complete the 9<sup>th</sup> sc, working over colour 1 and into the “eye” of the cluster [P3] make 9 tr, change to colour 1 and sc in next 9 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 2 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st.

Fasten off colour 2.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 20 sc. 9 tr.

Total: 160 sc, 72 tr.





27. Ch 1 and sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts,\* in ch-1 point space (sc, ch 1, sc), sc in next 8 sts, skip next 2 sts [P2], (dc in next tr, 2 dc in next tr) 4 times, dc in last tr, skip next 2 sts, sc in next 8 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 3 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc with a sl-st.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 18 sc, 13 dc. Total: 144 sc, 104 dc.

*Hint:*

*To stop colour 1 showing through, pick up with 1st dc.*



28. Ch 1 and sc in same st, sc in next 3 sts,\* in ch-1 point space (sc, ch 1, sc), sc in next 7 sts, skip next 2 sts, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) 6 times, dc in next dc, skip next 2 sts, sc in next 7 sts.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 4 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 16 sc, 19 dc.

Total: 128 sc, 152 dc.





29. Join with standing sc in any ch-1 point space, (ch 1, sc) in same space, \*sc in next 8 sts, **skip next dc**, [P3] (flsc in next dc, in same st (**fphdc**, 3 **fpdc**) skip next st, flsc in next st [*making a Ruffle st*], [P4 and 5]) 6 times, sc in next 8 sts, in ch-1 point space (sc, ch 1, sc).\*

Repeat from\* to \* 7 more times, omit last point group.

Join to standing sc, fasten off and secure ends.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 18 sc, 6 ruffle st.

Total: 144 sc, 48 ruffle st.



Part 3 is now complete. Give yourself a pat on the back, sit back and admire your amazing work, especially if this is your first time working with two colours.

30. Join with a standing sc in the sc **before** any ch-1 point space,  
 \*ch 1, skip ch-1 point space, sc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, skip next 3 sts [*2sc + flsc*],  
 (make 3 dc in the skipped st behind the ruffle st [*R28*] [*P 3,4,5*], skip next 2 sts) 5 times,  
 make 3 dc in last skipped st behind the last ruffle st [*R28*],  
 skip next 3 sts [*flsc + 2 sc*], hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next st.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last sc.

Join to standing sc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 2 sc, 12 hdc, 18 dc.

Total: 16 sc, 96 hdc, 144 dc.





31. Join with a standing sc in the sc before any ch-1 point space,

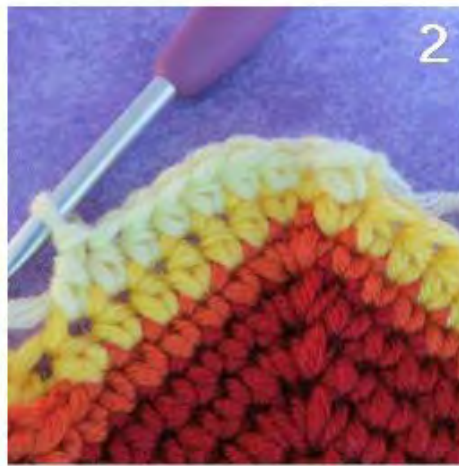
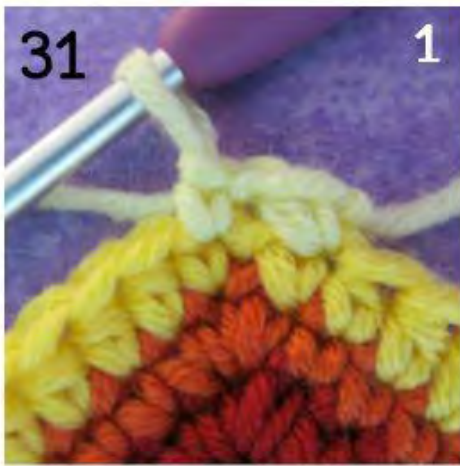
\*ch 1, skip ch-1 point space, sc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, dc in next 7 sts, tr in next 2 sts, 2 tr in next st, tr in next st, dc in next 7 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next st.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last sc.

Join to standing sc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch Count: Per repeat: 2 sc, 12 hdc, 14 dc, 5 tr.

Total: 16 sc, 96 hdc, 112 dc, 40 tr.



Hint: Please pay close attention to the spacing of the sc's. [P3]

32. Join with a standing **bpdc** in the 3<sup>rd</sup> tr of any side [*centre tr above ruffle sts*],  
(ch 1, **bpdc**) around same st, [*new point space made*]

**Extra Long Stitch:** Yarn over 7 times, insert hook into indicated stitch or space, yarn over and pull through 2 loops 8 times.

skip ch-1 space and next cluster, tr cluster in next ch-3 space, ch 1,

tr cluster in next ch-3 space, skip cluster and ch-1 space,

tr in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 8 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, tr in next 2 sts,

skip ch-1 space and next cluster, tr cluster in next ch-3 space, ch 1,

tr cluster in next ch-3 space, skip cluster and ch-1 space,

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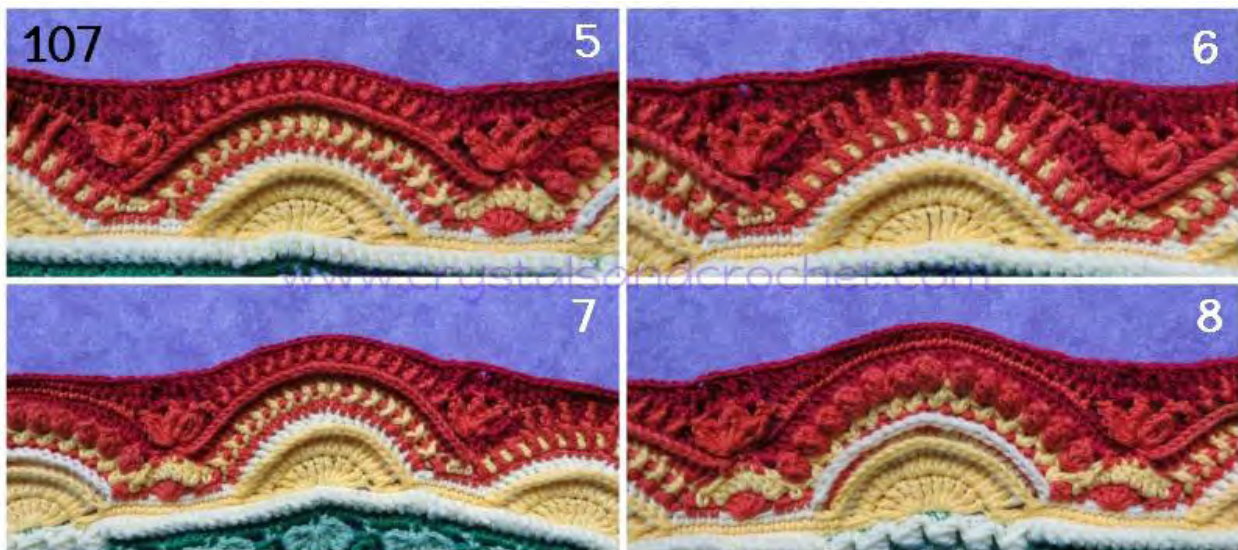

[shell 3] tr in next 4 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, tr in next 4 sts, [P2]

Skip cluster, tr cluster in ch-1 space, skip next cluster,

[shell 4] tr in next 4 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 9 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, tr in next 4 sts, [P3]

Skip cluster, tr cluster in ch-1 space, skip next cluster,

[shell 1] tr in next 4 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 11 sts. [P4]\*

Repeat from \* to \* 7 more times, omit last 11 sc.

Join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 33 sc, 24 hdc, 24 dc, 32 tr, 4 tr cluster.

Total: 264 sc, 192 hdc, 192 dc, 256 tr, 32 tr cluster.





109. Join with a standing dc in any st, dc in next 935 sts.

Join to standing dc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch Count: 936 dc.

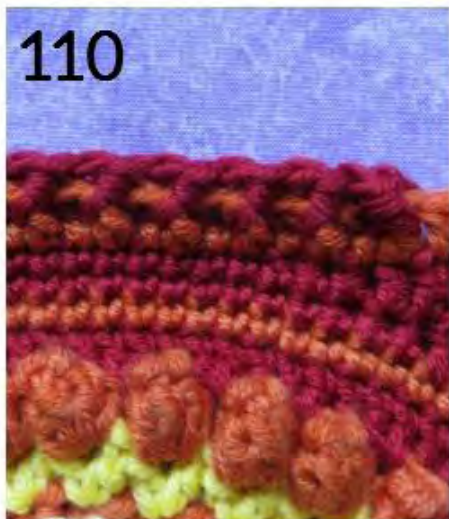
