Our Privacy Policy

Noble, Inc. uses its best effort to respect the privacy of its online visitors. In general, when you visit our website and access information, you remain anonymous. This means that at our site, we do not collect personally identifiable information from individuals unless they provide it to us voluntarily and knowingly. This means we do not require you to register or provide information to us in order to view our site. Noble, Inc. only gathers personally identifiable data like names, addresses, zipcodes and e-mail addresses when voluntarily submitted by a visitor. For example, personally identifiable information may be collected in order to respond to a stated desire to volunteer time to Noble or to make a financial donation online. This information is used for internal purposes solely by Noble, Inc. or other entities that are involved in the operation of this site. Noble, Inc. lists are never sold to third parties. We will only share personally identifiable information with third parties when:

- The person submitting the information authorizes us to share it;
- Sharing the information is a necessary operation of the site, for instance, to process a credit card gift; or
- We are required by law. Noble has no control over or responsibility for the data collection and use practices of third parties that process online donation credit card transactions.

We may provide links to third party sites. Since we do not control those websites, we encourage you to review the privacy policies posted on these third party sites.

Is Credit Card Information Secure?

We care about the safety and security of your transaction. We contract with a firm that uses high grade encryption and the https security protocol to communicate with your browser. This method is industry standard security protocol, which makes it extremely difficult for anyone else to intercept the credit card information you send to us. Noble, Inc. employs error-checking procedures to ensure transactions are processed completely and accurately. As necessary, changes are made to improve our systems. And, independent external and internal audits are conducted to ensure the privacy, security and appropriate processing of your information.

How Do We Use "Cookies"?

Visitors should be aware that non-personal information and data may be automatically collected by the Noble, Inc. website through the use of "cookies." These are small text files a website can use to recognize repeat visitors, facilitate visitors' ongoing access to and use of the site, and allow a site to track usage behavior and compile aggregate data that will allow content improvements. Cookies are not programs that transfer onto a visitor's system and damage files. Generally, cookies work by assigning a unique number to the visitor that has no meaning outside the assigning site. If a visitor does not want information collected through the use of cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows the visitor to deny or accept the cookie feature. Noble, Inc. uses "cookie" technology only to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors in order to improve visitors' online experience and facilitate their visit within our site.
