## **Application Rates & Timings**

Apply as a root drench.

For root repair: Apply @ 15 l/ha. In case of high root damage, repeat after 2-4 weeks.

As general tonic: Apply @ 15 l/ha. Repeat every 2-4 weeks or as required.

For freeze protection: Apply @ 10 - 15 l/ha. Repeat every 1-2 weeks during the month prior to

frost.

**Dilution:** Recommended for application at water rates of 400–600 l/ha (40-60ml/m<sup>2</sup>).

**Method:** Always use a fully calibrated sprayer at the recommended dosage.
