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Section A – Vessels Charges

Notes to Vessel Charges:

- (a) Unless otherwise stated, Vessel Dues are payable per Gross Tonne (GT) for each period of 5 days or part thereof during which the vessel is within port limits
- (b) Vessel Dues under sections I, II, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII and IX are payable in full for 1 charging period, thereafter a charge equating to 25% of the relevant charge per period will be payable
- (c) Unless otherwise stated, Berth Dues are payable per Gross Tonne (GT) for each period of 5 days or part thereof during which the vessel is alongside Wharfs or Quays owned or operated by the Port of Cromarty Firth
- (d) Please contact owners or operators of 3rd party Wharfs or Quays for their relevant facility charge
- (e) Charges specified under sections I-IX to be levied on vessels of 50GT and over entering the Port Limits
- (f) Charges are exclusive of V.A.T. Where applicable, V.A.T. will be charged
- (g) Volume discounts or rebates may be applied as deemed appropriate by the Authority
- (h) Rigs in firth beyond 90 days subject to additional Crown Estate charge (currently £25.15 per day)

	(b)	Where Pilots are over-carried outside the pilotage area or retained on board in unusual circumstances, an additional charge of £150 per hour will apply until disembarkation. All expenses incurred will also be rechargeable	
	(c)	Where support vessels are used for towing and moving vessels or structures, full pilotage will apply to the primary vessel with a 70% charge being levied to all support vessels
