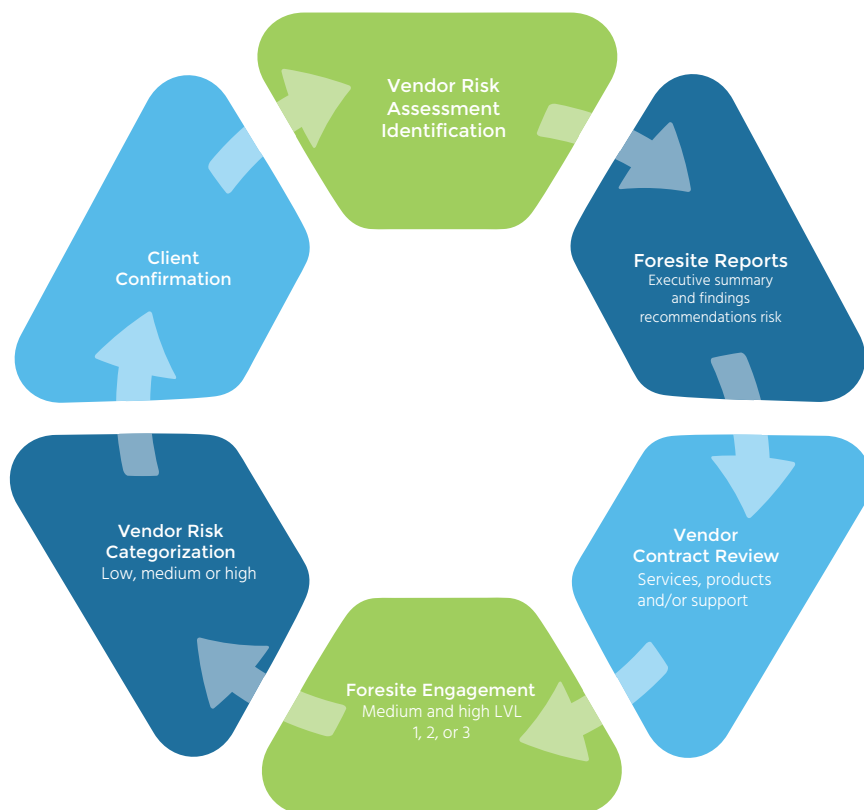

- 100–200-point questionnaire answered and reviewed
- Possible further assessments required
