

Outward Bound Centre, Buxworth

The Project

This old railway station in Buxworth, near Buxton, Derbyshire, owned by Buxworth Base Outward Bound required an upgrade of some facilities in order for it to be used again as an Outward Bound Centre.

Wilcox Construction Services were employed to design and construct various elements as follows;

- Modern unisex shower room/ toilets incorporating a disabled facility to future proof the facilities, together with all heating, and lighting etc
- Construction of new staircase to achieve a safer pitch. This involved alterations of the first floor layout and moving the 3 phase incoming electrical supply
- New external security fencing adjacent to the railway including negotiating with Railtrack on working method adjacent to the live rail lines
- Strip out of existing toilets and provision of new IT room
- Re-roofing sections and provision of additional insulation
