How it works

It's simple! We bring our gigantic Inflatible Museum to you and our team of museum educators run a fun and immersive workshop, all about the Romans in Dorset.

This unique and immersive learning environment will excite, engage and inspire your pupils, providing them with plenty of opportunity to handle and learn about real objects from the Museum's collection as well as all the inspiration that a trip to the museum can generate.

What you need to do

All you need to do is bring along a class of keen museum explorers and provide us with a space large enough for the Inflation Museum. We'll do the rest for you!

How much space do we need?

To allow for access (including exit in case of an emergency), the Inflation Museum must be set up indoors in a space of minimum 11m long, 9.5m wide and 4m high. It is therefore likely to be your school hall that accommodates us.

If you don't have a big enough space, perhaps you would consider a nearby village hall, or another school in the local area?



What are we offering you?

We will bring our Inflatible Museum along with real artefacts for an exciting, fun and engaging Roman themed workshop.

In small groups, pupils will be encouraged to think critically, weigh evidence and develop their historical enquiry skills by getting hands on with real objects from the Museum's collection. Pupils will also learn about the role of museums and discover what objects can reveal about people and places in the past.

How much does it cost?

The charge is £225 + VAT for 1 x KS2 class to take part in our two hour Roman themed workshop.

We are able to reduce this cost according to your Pupil Premium. Please contact us for more information.





How long do the workshops last?

Our workshops last around two hours and we can accommodate up to one class of Key Stage 2 pupils during one workshop.

If you would like us to deliver to more than one class we will do our best to accommodate you during a full day, however we are unable to offer more than two classes per day.

When can we visit?

We are able to visit schools on Tuesdays and Thursdays in term time only. Please book early to avoid disappointment.
