Tasty, nutritious school meals have been provided in the Bradford district for many years.

The Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme means these meals are provided FREE to all primary school children in reception class and Years 1 & 2.

There are no forms to fill in, or other eligibility criteria. So if your child is in one of these year groups, you can simply send them along to school to enjoy a delicious free lunch each day. If you would be eligible for free school meals (see criteria overleaf), it's important that you still register as your school will benefit from extra funding.


Please Note: For children in Years 3-6, meals will be priced at £1.80, which is still great value for money.

Your child is entitled to free school meals if you receive any of the following*:

- Income SupportUniversal Credit
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, if not receiving Working Tax Credit
 Immigration and Asylum Act 1990 Income-related Employment and
- Working Tax Credit run-on

- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit only)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
