

Registrations Procedure

- Learner contacts the local Peer Support Coordinator for more information on the course and information is sent to the learner. This includes the document Becoming a Breastfeeding Peer Supporter Volunteer in Cornwall and the link to the website, <u>https://realbabymilk.org/trainingcornwall/</u>
- 2. Signpost learner to enrol as a volunteer with the area's Children Centre or the hospital, this involves a County Council/hospital volunteer application form and DBS check.
- 3. The County Council or Hospital confirm with the Peer Support Coordinator the learner is a registered volunteer and therefore accepted on the course.
- 4. Send learner invitation to course, template below.
