

Homework-: Please make a contribution towards three homework books that will be used to set work for further practice to enable your child have their personal copy. The cost of contribution is £8.50 or £6.50 for pupils entitled to 'Pupils Premium funding. The books will be used out of sequence and each week the pages or exercises that support the work in class will be provided to your children.

Home reading: Please ensure that your child is reading for 20-30 minutes every day. Parents are expected to sign their childs home contact book every day. After listening to your child read, we would also be happy to read your comments. Please ensure your child brings their home contact journal to school every day.

Curriculum Subjects: Year 3 children will be experiencing a wide and varied curriculum this half term. **Refer to the sheet on the other page for an overview of each subject**. Our main topic is 'Was Everything Really Made of Stone?' which is a vibrant history based unit about the Stone Age. We will also link this to our science topic on 'Rocks'.

Oxford Reading Buddy (replacing Reading Eggs) is a program to support learning. All children have their personal login details to access them. Please encourage your child to login in daily and complete these home learning activities. Constant use supports their progress in Maths and Literacy. Teachers access the platform to check usage and assess progress.

School Uniform: It is essential that all children come to school in the correct uniform; yellow polo shirt, navy jumper, grey/navy skirt or trousers. Children must wear black school shoes, not trainers.

PE Kits: It is imperative all children participate in every PE lesson as this is part of the National Curriculum.
