



ROBERTSON FUEL SYSTEMS AWARDED \$176M CONTRACT FOR PROCUREMENT OF FUEL SYSTEMS FOR APACHE AH-64

PHOENIX, Oct. 2, 2017 – Robertson Fuel Systems (RFS), a HEICO Company and renowned provider of military-grade fuel systems, has been awarded a \$175,969,611 firm-fixed-price domestic and foreign military sales contract. The contract is to procure auxiliary fuel systems including reduced-size crashworthy external fuel systems and internal auxiliary fuel systems for the Apache AH-64.

Bids were solicited via the Internet with one received. Funding will be determined with each order, with an estimated completion date of Dec. 31, 2021. U.S. Army Contracting Command, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama, is the contracting activity.

The external and internal fuel systems are crashworthy and ballistically self-sealing. They provide Apache mission commanders with added mission flexibility by providing additional fuel for tactical missions and the external fuel has no flight limitations.
