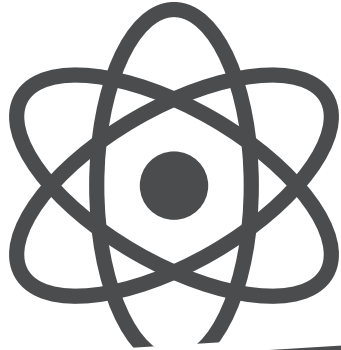


REBUILT DARLINGTON NUCLEAR STATION



ELECTRICITY BILL

LOSE

Ontario adds to provincial debt load and remains locked into costly and inflexible nuclear power for the next 40 years

Provincial debts and deficits rise

LOSE

Quebec locked into existing US Northeast market where prices are falling and transmission capacity is at capacity

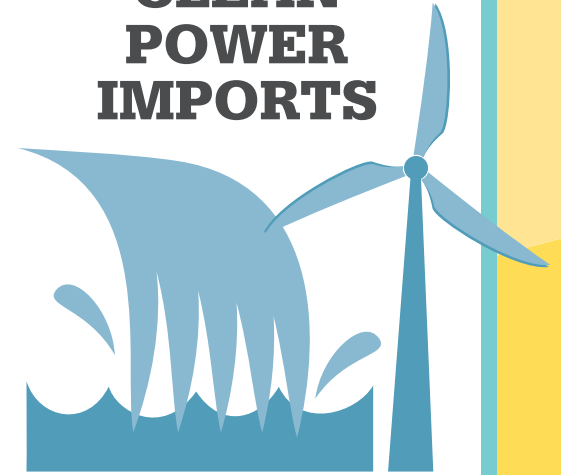
BILLS UP

No nuclear project ever completed on time or on budget in Ontario

BILLS DOWN

Existing transmission lines can carry power equal to 97% of the output of Darlington

WIN

Ontario saves \$600 million per year – \$12 billion over a 20 year contract

WIN

Quebec earns \$600 million more per year than it would from exports to the US with no need for new transmission lines to increase capacity
