Tynemouth Station, a Grade II listed building, and was on the English Heritage Buildings at Risk register due to the condition of its canopies. Lathams carried our architectural and conservation services in support of a Sea Change grant application, and from there we were chosen to provide full architectural services for the whole project.

The proposal was part of a joint bid with Hodder & Partners, who we've worked with in the past and who were responsible for the new-build element of the project. Our remit was to repair as found, so we could retain as much material as possible on site.
