

Catch Up Funding 2018-19

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives state-funded schools, including special schools and alternative provision settings, additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

In the academic year 2018/19, 40 pupils are eligible for £500 Catch Up Fudingeach. The funding allocation is \pounds 20,000

The objectives of the funding are:

- To close the attainment gap by providing literacy and numeracy support to students entitled to the catch up funding
- To enhance the existing provision
- To identify concerns and target intervention and support to accelerate progress
