The Texas Association of Public Insurance Adjusters (TAPIA) Conference Committee is seeking *presentation proposals* for our Fall 2019 Conference, October 16-17, 2019, Embassy Suites Fort Worth Downtown.

- Meet TDI requirements for continuing education credits.

- Present old information in new and interesting ways.
- Are completed according to directions and submitted on time.
- Have not presented to a TAPIA conference in the past 12 months.

Fall 2019 focus: FIRE! Trends & Tips for Public Adjusters

The Conference Committee wants to provide participants with useful, in-depth information about best practices for identifying, assessing, and documenting hail damage; the most common policy coverage issues for fire losses; what PAs need to know about trends and advances in materials, technology, and legal issues, and other issues specific to residential and commercial fire losses.

IMPORTANT: The proposal packet has changed to include completion of the timed outline required for TDI approval for CE credits. Proposals that do not sufficiently address the timed outline will be returned to the sender and will not be included in the selection process (but may be resubmitted before the deadline). *Call or send email to the TAPIA office if you have questions or need samples of successful submissions.*
