CIOB (Chartered Institute of Building) Diploma in Site Management

What will I learn?

Both the CIOB Certificate and the CIOB Diploma in Site Management courses are ideal if you would like to move into a site management role, or you are keen to progress into a more senior role in the industry.

To start this Diploma course you must successfully complete the Certificate course first.

All our courses are designed to cover the full range of topics and tasks as laid down by the awarding body in response to industry requirements. All practical activities are carried out within out state of the art workshops with theory work being a mix of classroom and assignment activities.

All 12 units are mandatory to achieve the Diploma qualification. The completion of any 4 units (which MUST include Managing Health, Safety, Welfare and Risk Control at Work) is required to achieve the CIOB Certificate in Site Management (Level 4).

Project Planning, Project Control & Monitoring, Managing the Quality of Site Work, Managing Health, Safety, Welfare and Risk Control at Work, Managing Dimensional Control on Sites, Developing & Managing People, Improving Managerial Skills, Contractual & Legal Responsibilities, Estimating & Measuring Work, Managing Sub-Contractors, Managing Building Services, & Managing Technology of Modern Construction.

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

For entry to the CIOB Diploma you must have successfully completed the CIOB Certificate in Site Management Level 4, which we also offer at BDC.

What can I do after this course?

After completion of the CIOB Certificate you are eligible for Associate Membership of the CIOB (ACIOB). After completing the Diploma you are eligible to apply for Incorporate Membership of CIOB (ICIOB). On completion of the Diploma you will be eligible to apply for a Black Site Managers CSCS card.

The scheme is recognised as a means of up skilling and may attract funding if you are unemployed.

Also grants are available to employers within scope to the CITB.
