Scene & Heard is seventeen years old, and to date we have 311 Member Playwrights, have run 78 courses and produced 578 pieces of new writing. We hold The Queen's Award for Voluntary Service and a Centre for Social Justice Award.

## Over The Top The Audacious Plays

Our Replay production this year, Over the Top - The Audacious Plays, featured the incomparable Catriona Knox as third woman, popping up to change the course of action of each play in a range of guises, including a sasquatch, an atom, a top hat, the God of Destruction and a mermaid.

**The Daring Plays** was our Playmaking One production in July. The glorious array of characters included: a murderous musky fish, a honeycomb with aspirations to rule all Victorians, a spikey rubber ball who aims to end world poverty and a monkey who wants to be a stand-up comedian.



## Me And My Shadow

We were delighted to perform Me & My Shadow, our One-on-One production, at New Diorama Theatre in Regent's Place. Eleven young people, returning to work with us for, in most cases, the fourth time, each had a play written for them by a professional writer. The course was taught with humour and charm by Gordon Peaston, supported by Suzie Foster, and the production featured some amazing performances by our young people with their adult partners.

## **Stage One**

In May 2016 nine young people aged 11 – 13 joined Roz and a team of volunteers to create their own mini plays over a weekend of intense creativity at Diorama Arts Studios. By Sunday afternoon each piece was complete. The young people alongside their adult partners performed their piece as a rehearsed reading for an audience of family and friends. Stage One is an inspiring example of what can be achieved in just 48 hours.

As we go to print our final production of the year, Scream & Shout - The Noisy Plays, is in rehearsal. We know it's going to be a wonderfully fitting end to another fantastic year of playwriting at Scene & Heard.



## **Theatre Trips**

Theatre trips have become a regular feature of our year, allowing us to keep in touch with our young people whether they are participating in a course or not. 

# Dear Member Playwrights, Volunteers and Supporters,

This year Scene & Heard began implementing our long term strategic plan, establishing ourselves as a **Centre of Excellence**. We advise other charities and local organisations as well as extending our own work within the Somers Town community. I am delighted that a number of our older Member Playwrights have come back to do their **Work Experience** with us, helping out during production weeks. They have painted the set, sewn and glued costumes, shopped for a crazy array of curious yet vital items, researched, drawn and meticulously coloured in our hallmark 2D props and proved a valuable addition to our hardworking production teams.

This summer I had the chance to visit the 52<sup>nd</sup> Street Project in New York: the playwriting and mentoring project that was the inspiration for Scene & Heard. Established thirty years ago, they're considerably older than us. They have their

own building with theatre, workshops, afterschool club and rehearsal space. Needless to say I was rather envious of all their facilities and their kit! It was an absolute joy to meet some of the fantastic team over there, to see their beautiful theatre, to delight in their props and to share stories of the work that we do on opposite sides of the Atlantic. We do some things very differently and others are strikingly similar, but the ethos at the heart of what we do, to use theatre as a tool to mentor and inspire young people, is as true for them as it is for us.



Scene & Heard is currently developing a new course as an alternative to *Playback*, to offer our older Member Playwrights a further opportunity to write with us. We plan to pilot *Writeback* in Autumn 2017.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the volunteers - actors, writers, directors, dramaturgs, prop makers, composers, envelope stuffers and interns - as well as our wonderful staff, patrons, trustees, designers and technical teams for another fabulously successful year - well done all!


