## 30 Hours Free Childcare- Do you qualify?

- All parents in the household work the equivalent of at least 16 hours at national living wage or national minimum wage, earning at least £131.36 per week from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.
- No one parent in the family household earns over £100,000.
- One parent is employed and one parent has substantial caring responsibilities based on specific benefits received for caring.
- Both parents are employed but one or both parents are temporarily away from the workplace on parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave.
- Both parents are employed but one or both parents are temporarily away from the workplace on statutory sick pay.
- One parent is employed and one parent is disabled or incapacitated based on receipt of specific benefits.
- Self-employed parents and parents on zero-hours contracts will be eligible if they meet the average earnings criteria.
