Bulle Campus - Switzerland

- The semester includes 15 weeks of teaching and two weeks of final exams.
- Upon completion of the semester abroad, students will receive a course transcript listing the corresponding passed credits.
- Credit transfer to the student's university is subject to evaluation by their current university.

Admission Requirements

Minimum Age - 18 years old at the start of semester

Minimum English Language Entry Requirements

If English is not your first language, or if you have not spent the last two years studying in a school where English is the primary language of instruction, please enclose a copy of one of the following:

- International English Language Test (IELTS):
 6 overall (min. 5.5 in every subcomponent)
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TŒFL):
 550 (paper-based) 80 (internet-based)
- · First Cambridge Exam: Grade A or Cambridge Advanced Exam: Grade C
- For London, same as above, except Non-EU or EEA passport holders will need to undertake IELTS UKVI: 5.5 overall and min. 5.5 in every subcomponent.
