5. All entry forms must be submitted one week prior to competition
6. Entries received on the day of judging will not be entered.
7. Exhibitors can enter a maximum of two entries per class, but only one can be placed.
8. Results will be announced after each competition, via Website/email/Post
9. Challenge Cups and Certificates will be presented at the Society's Annual Dinner. Collection to be made in person or by nominated person.
