
FUNDRAISING PACK EVERYONE NEEDS A PLACE TO CALL...





ABOUT US THE BOND BOARD IS A CHARITY WHICH HELPS HOMELESS PEOPLE OR THOSE THREATENED WITH LOSING THEIR HOME TO SECURE AND MAINTAIN AFFORDABLE ACCOMMODATION IN THE PRIVATE RENTED SECTOR IN BOLTON AND ROCHDALE.

We do this by providing landlords with a written deposit guarantee, also known as a bond, which takes the place of a cash deposit. This enables homeless households to gain access to accommodation, which they otherwise would not be able to, as our clients are often in great financial hardship.

Additionally, we have a number of other services to help people settle into their accommodation, maintain their tenancies, improve their general and economic wellbeing and start to rebuild their lives. This includes: an advice and support service, a pilot lodgings scheme, and a Social Letting Agency, to meet the needs of young homeless people.

We work tirelessly to raise standards, improve practice and share information about the private rented sector by running workshops and training sessions for both tenants and landlords.

What are we fundraising for?

We have two funds:

The Bond Pot

By contributing towards a bond, you will provide the means for a homeless person or family to gain a roof over their heads.

- £250 provides a bond to house a single homeless person.
- £425 provides a bond for a family with children.

As over 60% of our bonds are returned unclaimed at the end of someone's tenancy, we are able to reuse your money again and again to house other homeless people. Without your support, this would not be possible.

The Homeless Independence Fund

Once people have found a place to call home, we are committed to making every effort to ensure we offer the support and financial assistance to help them begin their journey towards independence, minimise the risks of a return to homelessness and increasing people's chances to a more stable and self-sustaining future.

This is where we developed the idea to raise money to go into a Homeless Independence Fund. This fund provides homeless and recently housed people with the means to move towards independence. This could range from items needed to set up a home, provide basic toiletries, paying for a copy of someone's birth certificate so they can set up a bank account and access other services, engage in training and educational opportunities, or clothes for someone to attend a job interview. These are just some recent examples of how we have helped people on their journey towards independence - the list is by no means exhaustive!

Your donation will change someone's life. You'll be surprised to learn that any amount we receive, can be put to good use and make a real difference to someone who has experienced homelessness.

THE DIFFERENCE You can make

Homelessness affects a wide variety of people and anyone can become homeless for many different reasons. Over the years we have helped people from all walks of life, all with their stories to tell. Here are just a few, we'd like to share with you...

Lee

I found myself homeless and living on the streets after being in hospital for a while, due to mental health issues and alcohol misuse. I contacted The Bond Board, who helped me to find a one bed flat that was available immediately.

I was interviewed and accepted for the bond, which was also issued the very same day. With thanks to this organisation, I did not have to go through the trauma of spending another night on the street.

The Bond Board did not stop there. They continued with their on-going support, including: advising and helping me to apply for housing benefit, liaised with the landlord to provide me with new carpets making my flat more homely and referred me to a floating support service, which meant I could continue receiving support.

With thanks to The Bond Board, I am now getting help for my mental health and alcohol issues and I am settling into my new property.

Suzie

I met and fell in love with a man. I thought he would take me and my daughter on, but after we moved in with him, I felt that he hated my daughter. It wasn't an easy decision, deciding whether to make myself and my daughter homeless.

He owned everything in the property. So when we left, we left with the clothes that we were stood up in and a few bits and bobs. That was it! I had nowhere really to go, with no money and no job. We had to physically start again from complete scratch. That was one of the worst challenges I've ever faced in my life!

I went to the homeless section. They helped me look for accommodation and also gave me the number for The Bond Board. The Bond Board helped me from the very first meeting I had with them. They pay your bond on a house, tell you where there are furniture shops and grants you can get. The work that they do just gives you a way forward and makes you feel a lot better in yourself and makes you stronger to get through it.

Things are looking up. I've actually got a home for me and my daughter, that I can call my own. My daughter is so happy now and my next step is to go back to the work that I loved!

Plant sale


Sponsored walk, run, bike ride, swim, etc.


Sports matches – charge teams to enter competitions in rounders, cricket, football, pool, darts, etc.

By creating an online fundraising page you can very quickly reach a large audience as well as providing people with a quick and secure way to pay. There are numerous charity giving web-sites available, such as, MyDonate, Charity Choice and JustGiving to name but a few.

Money Raised

Once you have completed your fundraising event. There are a number of ways you can send the money to us. Please feel free to:

- Make us a bank transfer (Account number: 50011531, Sort code: 08-90-18). Please quote your name as a reference, so we know who's made the donation.
- Send us a cheque made payable to, "The Bond Board Ltd".
- Drop off the donation into one of our offices.
- Make us a donation on-line, we have a fundraising page on MyDonate and Charity Choice.

We are registered for gift aid, so please ask any donors who are UK tax payers to tick the gift aid box, provide their full name, home address including their postcode on sponsor forms. By asking UK taxpayers to Gift Aid their donations, we can get an extra 25% on top of their donation amount, without it costing the donor any more. So for every £1 donation, we can increase it to £1.25. Please send in any sponsor forms to us to allow us to claim gift aid.

THE DIFFERENCE WE MAKE

We plough our resources into helping the most marginalised and disadvantaged groups of people. Without the support and generosity from people like you, this cannot be possible.

Since we began in 1993, we have housed over 6,000 homeless households, and in any one year, we are supporting over 650 households in accommodation by providing the bond guarantee. Last year, we issued 284 new bonds to accommodate 310 adults and 134 children into safe and secure accommodation.

We also offer a number of other services which work holistically with homeless people, to enable them to successfully maintain their new homes, increase independence and future prospects and to avoid a repeat cycle of homelessness. On a practical level, we fundraise to enable us to house people and to provide people with the means to purchase household or personal items to help them settle into their accommodation when they have no other way of doing so, or offer financial assistance to help people rebuild their lives and begin their journey to independence.

We feel the complete package of support we offer, helps people break the cycle of homelessness. This can be demonstrated in our figures last year where 66% of households with a bond, are showing they have settled by remaining in their properties for longer than 12 months, this figure is similar year on year.
