

Turbuhaler®

The Turbuhaler has a dose indicator on the barrel of the inhaler. It counts down the number of doses as you use them.

Before Using a New Turbuhaler:

A new Turbuhaler must be prepared before you can use it. Follow the steps below the first time you use a new Turbuhaler.

- 1. Twist the cover and lift it off.
- 2. Hold the Turbuhaler with the mouthpiece pointing up.
- 3. Turn the brown grip on the bottom all the way to the right and then back to the left. You will hear a click.

The Turbuhaler is now primed and ready to be loaded with a dose.

Loading a Dose of Medicine:

You load the Turbuhaler with a dose of medicine in the same way that you prepare a new device for use. Follow these steps.

- 1. Twist the cover and lift it off.
- Hold the Turbuhaler with the mouthpiece pointing up to load the medicine correctly into the chamber.
- 3. Twist the brown grip to the right as far as it will go and then back to the left. You will hear a click. The device is ready to use.

Breathing In the Medicine:

- 4. First, gently breathe out as much air as you can.
- Seal your lips around the Turbuhaler mouthpiece. Be sure to hold the inhaler in a horizontal position.
- 6. Breathe in through your mouth. Hold your breath for 10 seconds.
- Remove the Turbuhaler from your mouth. Then, resume normal breathing. Rinse your mouth with water and spit it out.
- 8. If more than one dose is prescribed, repeat steps 1 through 7 for each dose.
- After you have finished taking a treatment, place the cover on the Turbuhaler and twist it completely closed. This will keep it clean and dry.

Turbuhaler Notes:

- · Keep the Turbuhaler closed when not in use.
- · Keep the Turbuhaler dry. If the mouthpiece gets dirty, wipe it with a cloth.
- When a red mark appears in the dose indicator window, there are 20 doses left.
 As soon as you see the red mark, refill your prescription.
