Access Document

Parking

We have onsite parking which is free of charge. Disabled bays are marked with a sign. They are the spaces located nearest to the entrance. Please do not drive up to the ticket kiosk unless already arranged with us.

Pathway

The pathway around the monkey enclosure itself is $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile long. The pathway is fairly smooth and even, made up of a hardcore base and a layer of dust. It is wheelchair friendly; however, some people may struggle due to some steeper slopes. If you do struggle, this is not a problem, you can simply miss out the top group of monkeys and spend more time sitting and watching the monkey antics – we always recommend doing this any way!

The route that avoids the steeper slopes has been marked on the map below. It includes visiting the first group of monkeys and then following the stream down the 'valley' section of the forest before coming back on yourself to the forest exit.

Toilet Facilities

We have 1 disabled access toilet onsite, located in the main toilet block. The toilet includes larger doorways and rails to cater for a variety of needs.

Café/Shop

The onsite Banana Café and Jungle Shop are accessible to all. The doorways are large and the floors are smooth and open, without steps.

Wheelchairs

We do not have wheelchairs for hire at Monkey Forest
