


# **AES PIPE SEAL**

Flexible connection system for pipes to manholes and laterals to pipelines.



## **SEAL DESIGN AND FUNCTION**

The AES pipe seal is a rubber seal for flexible connection of pipes to manholes and laterals to pipelines. It can be used with both prefabricated and core drilled holes.

The triple lip design allows ease of jointing and provides excellent resistance to transverse shear load whilst allowing a high level of angular deflection in the joint.


The wide range of sizes available ensure the watertight connection of almost any pipe diameter and material.

AES pipe seal can also be used for connecting PVC pipes into corrugated pipes.



#### **SEAL PERFORMANCE**

The AES pipe seal meets the requirement of all relevant current European standards. Joint performance is dependent on dimensional accuracy and surface finish of pipe and hole.



#### **MATERIAL**

Synthetic rubber SBR or EPDM

Hardness 40±5 IRHD

Approved in accordance with EN 681-1


Protected against ozone

Available in oil rersistant material


#### **JOINT ASSEMBLY**



Press the seal into the hole. Do not use lubricant.




Chamfer the edge of the connecting pipe and lubricate it.



Centre the end of the pipe and push it into the seal, so that the pipe end is flush with the inner wall.

### **SEAL MARKING AND BOX LABELS**

Each seal is marked with outside diameter and profile thickness, plus the recommended pipe and hole diameter and period of manufacture. The box is labelled with corresponding data.



# **EXAMPLES OF SIZES (MM)**

A - MM	B - MM	Joint gap
16.0	38.0	10.5±1.3
20.0 *	50.0	13.0±1.8
23.0	51.0	15.0±1.9
26.6	49.2	17.3±2.0
32.0	49.5	20.8±2.4

\* For EN 1401 PVC Pipe DN 110mm the profile thickness is 21.5 mm and the joint gap is 14.0  $\pm$  1.8mm.
