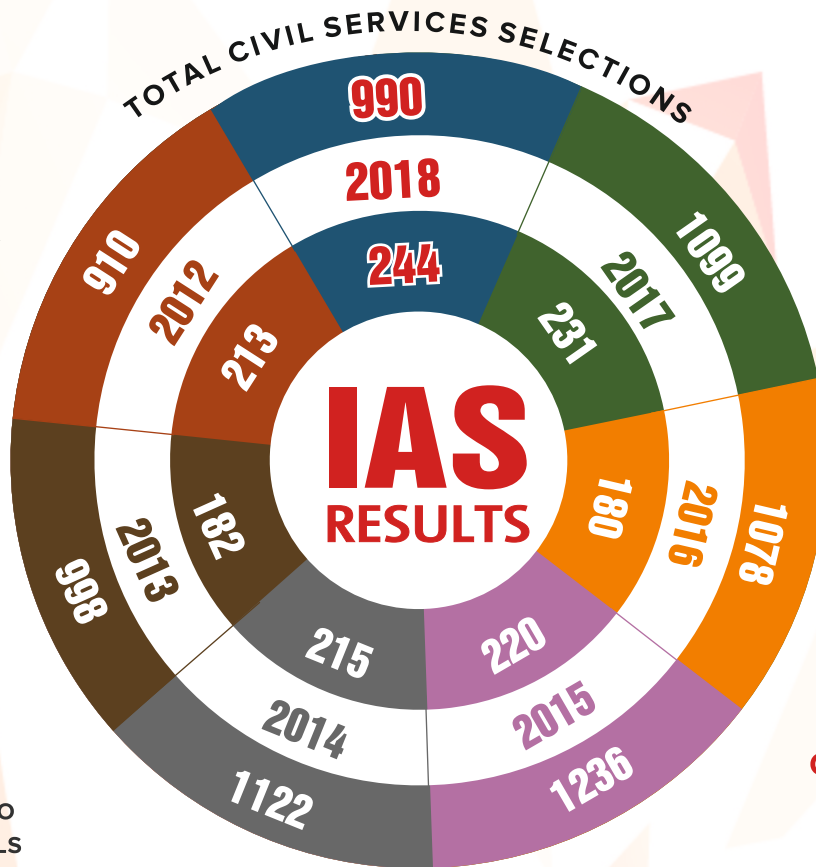

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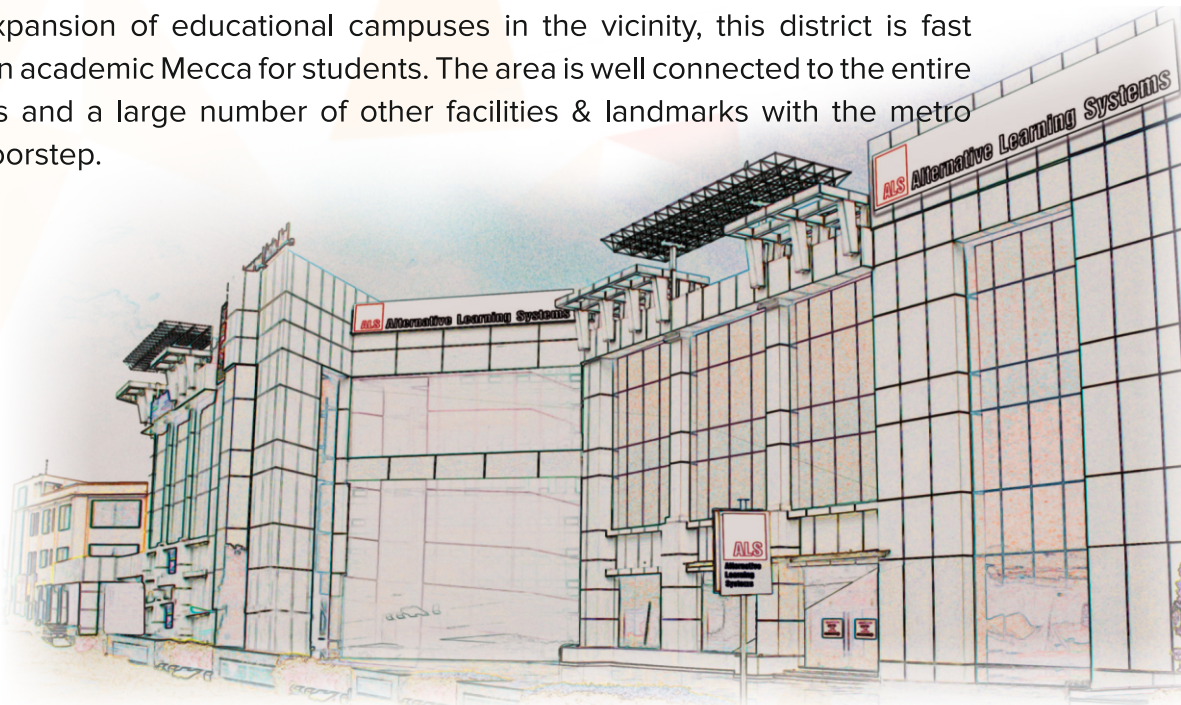

Another key ALS campus is located in Central Delhi in a vibrant commercial district environment. This student-centric campus is in a colourful area renowned for its intriguing cultural significance.

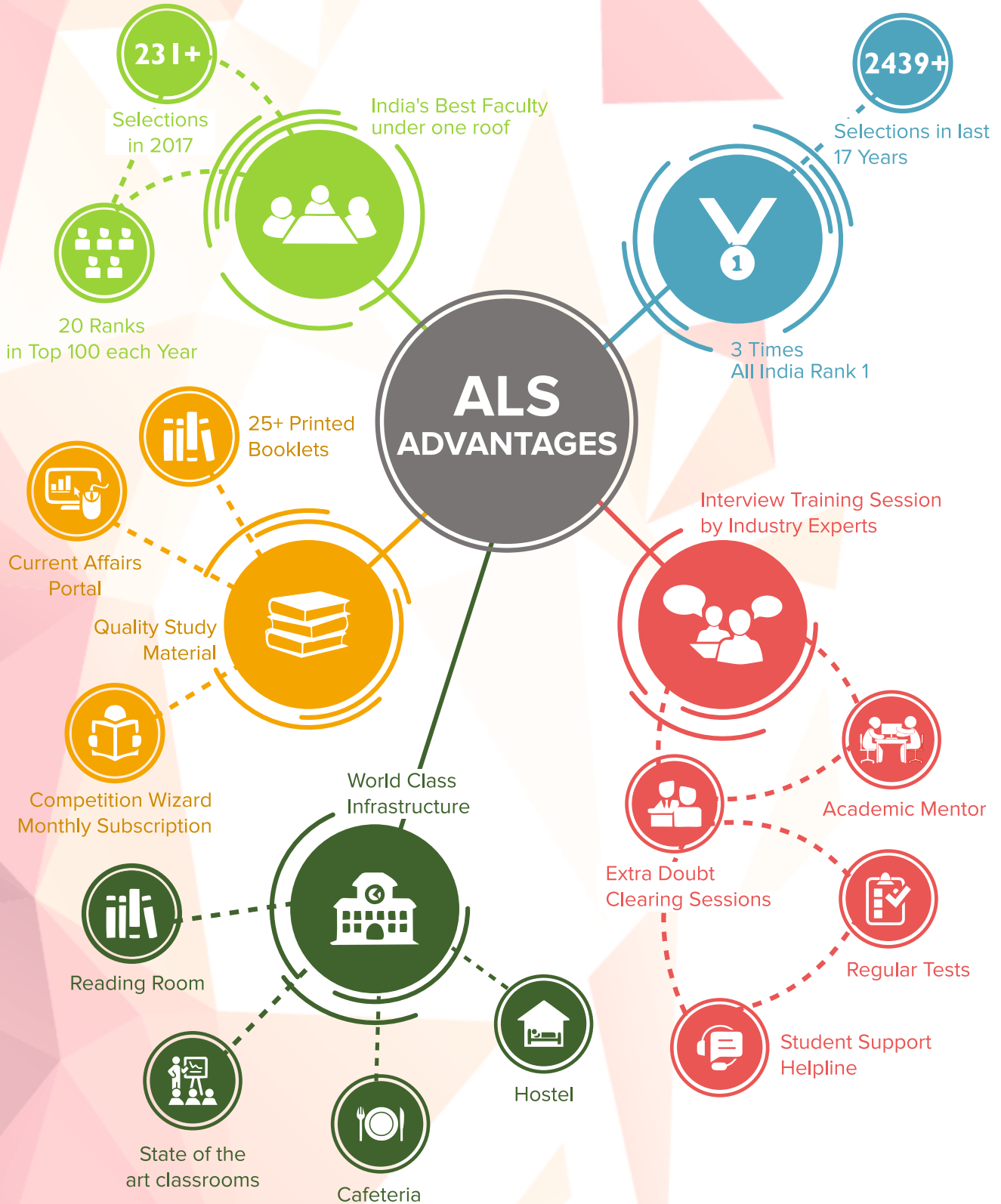

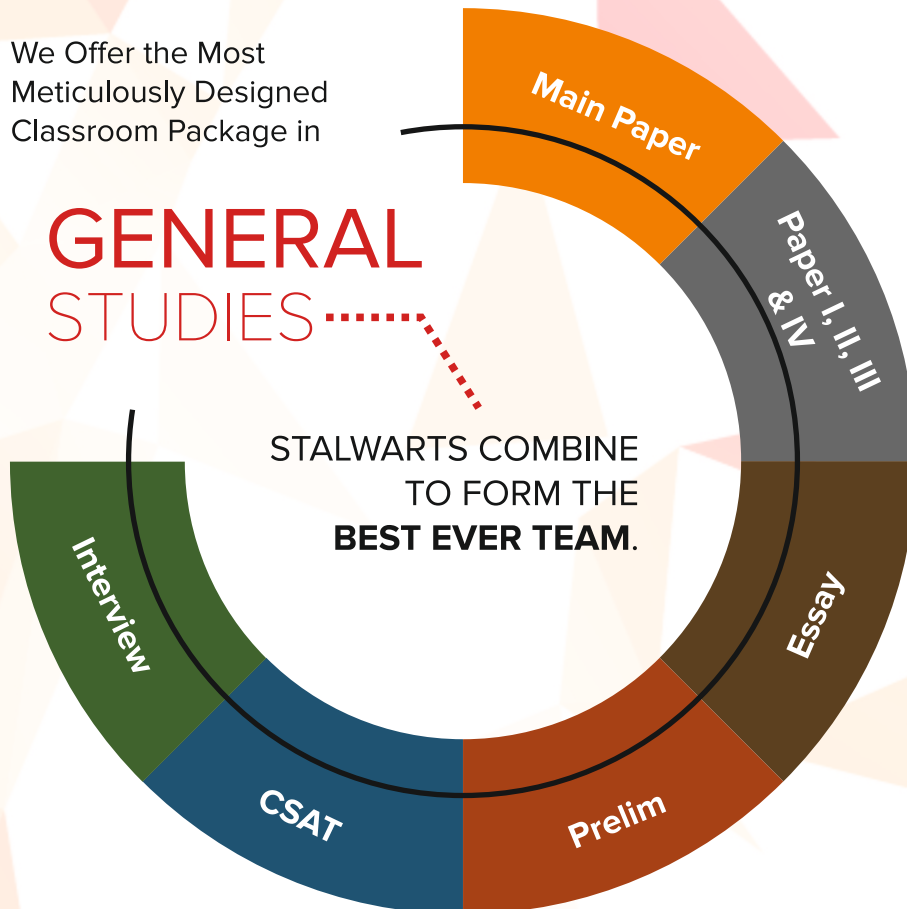
