Beginning in January your source for WeatherLock® G Ice & Water Barrier underlayment will convert from the Brentwood, New Hampshire facility to our Houston, Texas production facility. You'll still enjoy the same great quality, but you'll notice a packaging enhancement. Due to customer preference, Houston produced product will be poly-wrapped instead of coming in cartons.

Note: The new WeatherLock® G Ice & Water Barrier underlayment produced in Houston will be mixable with WeatherLock® G underlayment produced in Brentwood.

Our change to poly-wrapped packaging is inspired by contractor feedback that cardboard causes waste, damage and is not the preferred packaging to handle on the roof.

We will manage this as a running change, beginning to take orders for the new material as soon as January 9, 2017. New material will begin to ship by January 23, 2017 or as your plant inventory of the 788767 product is sold through.
