

## GRILL WINES

Specially chosen to suit beef in all its guises, the wines all deliver good tannins (savoury and gamey), medium to full bodied weight & real character. Our new house pouring beef recommendation is a rich, super-charged Carmenere which over delivers. A grape variety that was for years found to be languishing in the shadows and in amongst the vines of the Merlot grape, it has seen a remarkable rejuvenation.

**Carmenere – Bin 31** £3.60 125ml £4.85 175ml £6.75 250ml £18.95  
Casa Filipe, Central Valley, Chile  
Juicy, succulent fruit laden peppered with spice and herbs on a warm, savoury tail.

**Malbec – Bin 32** £22.50  
Chamuyo, Mendoza, Argentina  
Gutsy, with ripe summer fruits, herbs and a warm spicy finish.

**Crianza Vina Belezos, – Bin 33** £17.50 ½'s £27.95  
Bodegas Zugober, Rioja, Spain  
Stunning Crianza from one of the new stars of the region crafted in a traditional style but with a delicious fragrant and fresh angle.

**Il Barroccio Rosso – Bin 34** £18.95  
Sicily, Italy  
Irresistably juicy Sicilian quaffer oozing black fruits underpinned with a remarkable complexity of herbal notes with a dry, savoury length

**Malbec – Bin 35** £31.95  
Ruca Malen, Mendoza, Argentina  
Stunning purity of fruit with big flavours and savoury tannins. This wine is made for beef.

## SEAFOOD WINES

We continue to develop our choice of seafood so it would seem appropriate to list a few seafood 'classics'. From the fresh & lively Picpoul to the multi-layered Pinot Gris, the following list offers varying degrees of weight and textures to match the diversity of Head Chef Duncan's flavours.

**Viognier – Bin 41** £3.60 125ml £4.85 175ml £6.75 250ml £18.95  
Puertas Antiguas, Central Valley, Chile  
Delicate blossom & stone fruit notes with a lush, mouth-filling palate. A real gem.

**Picpoul de Pinet – Bin 42** £22.95  
Domaine Morin-Langaran, Languedoc, France  
The 'Muscadet of the south. Citrus fruits with a mineral core and a fresh, bone-dry salty tang.

**Pinot Gris – Bin 43** £29.95  
Erabus, Marlborough, New Zealand  
'Food-friendly' PG that is produced in a more Alsatian/marginally off-dry style. Fresh yet broad on the palate with zingy citrus characters and some stone-fruit and spice.

**Chablis - Bin 44** £19.95 ½'s £32.95  
Vincent Damp, Burgundy, France  
Balanced Chablis with striking minerality and intense fruit.

## WHITES

Bright passion fruit aromas and a classically crisp acidity.

Reserva, Vina Mar, Casablanca Valley, Chile  
Beautiful toned & balanced cool climate Chardonnay – tropical & citrus fruits with hints of toast & vanilla.

**Sauvignon/Semillon – Bin 5** £23.95  
La Combe de Grinou, Bergerac, France  
Clean & zesty with grassy appeal leading to dry, bitter lemon infused palate.

**Ana Sauvignon Blanc – Bin 6** £27.50  
Michiel Eradus, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Aromatic with cut grass, gooseberry flavour and citrus acidity.

**Macon Solutre – Bin 7** £17.95 ½'s £29.50  
Maison Auvigues, Burgundy, France  
Nicely judged south Burgundian Chardonnay delivering apple/citrus freshness with delicate, mineral structure.

**Ernie Els, Sauvignon Blanc – Bin 8** £32.95  
Western Cape, South Africa  
Fresh and lively, beautifully perfumed with green peppercorn & asparagus in evidence leading to a juicy, clean fresh tropical fruit palate and nice, herbal length.

Moreish, with dark cherry fruit and a fragrant, herbal finish.

Dry and medium bodied with ripe, sweet forest fruits on the nose finished with soft, plummy tannins.
- Tempranillo – Bin 14** £21.95  
Mas Oliveras, Catalunya, Spain  
Soft and aromatic, with a chocolaty texture and notes of ripe strawberry and liquorice.
- Shiraz – Bin 15** £19.50  
Puertas Antiguas, Central Valley, Chile  
Rich, rounded with bramble fruit characters and a warm mocha coating
- Pinot Noir – Bin 16** £17.50 ½'s £27.50  
La Tunella, Colli Orientali del Friuli, Italy  
Intense flavours of cherry and red fruits with a velvety, ripe structure.
- Cotes du Rhone – Bin 17** £27.50  
Vignobles Gonnet, Southern Rhone, France  
Silky red fruits, polished yet with a rustic edge of pepper spice, earth and tannic grip.
- Soraie, Cecilia Beretta– Bin 18** £28.50  
Veneto, Italy  
A 'baby Amarone' ... red fruits, plums, coffee & spice with a dusting of cocoa flow effortlessly to a crunchy, ripe fruit on a fresh, medium-bodied palate and length of silky fruit purity.
- Zinfandel – Bin 19** £42.50  
Edmeades, Mendocino County, USA  
90 points –Wine Enthusiast –heady aromas of dark fruits and spice with toasty elegance.
- St Emilion, Grand Cru, – Bin 20** £44.95  
Château Barrail du Blanc, Bordeaux, France  
Classic Grand Cru St. Emilion. Earthy, with dark fruit flavours and a long, silky finish.
- Amarone della Valpolicella Classico – Bin 21** £54.95  
Cecilia Beretta, Veneto, Italy  
Beautifully balanced and majestic with layer upon layer of sweet raisiny fruits, wild herbs & spice upon a wonderfully opulent palate.

A staff favourite ... gorgeous aromatics on this ... deeply coloured, perfumed & fresh, super charged black fruits, text book pepper and mild toasty notes. Finely balanced with a luxurious structure and length.
