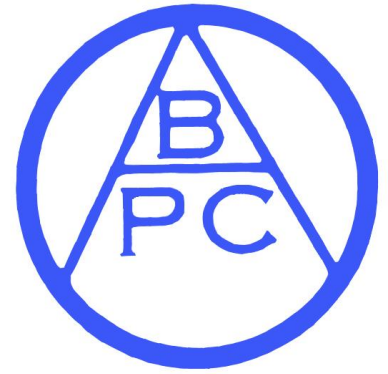

The Theme of Past, Present and Future will feature throughout the conference, with Speakers from the Worshipful Company of Pewterers, the ABPC as well as interesting and lively presentations from designers and those working in the creative industries.

As per previous years the conference will take place over two days, with the Friday featuring Factory Tours and the launch of the Pewter Now exhibition at Kelham Island Museum. Delegates will also get the chance to see the new Pewter Workshop at the museum during a private viewing. There will be a Welcome Dinner at the hotel in the evening. Saturday morning is the conference followed by an informal lunch. For those wishing to stay on to the afternoon, there will be the opportunity to visit the Millennium galleries in Sheffield, where there will be a curatorial talk on the Metalwork Collection and also a chance to view the Leonardo Da Vinci exhibition featuring selected pieces from the Royal Collection.
