1. Latin Bible      “**Biblia**”. Thick Small Folio. (11x8x3½”). **31<sup>st</sup> December 1482**. Nuremberg. **Anton Koberger**. Gothic Letter. Double Columns. 53 lines to a main column. 459 (of 462) leaves i.e. lacks the initial & final blank leaves & one leaf of text in Genesis (Folio 7). Large initial ‘E’ first leaf (2x2½”) with pen work flourish, rubricated in red. Red paragraph marks & initial strokes. Occasional ink marginalia. First leaf re-margined (NAT). 1<sup>st</sup> 6 leaves either on inner guards or with slight marks there (NAT). 5 leaf section at leaf 210 with upper inner marginal worming (NAT). Outer upper marginal repair through 6 leaves in Corinthians, just affecting a few lines on one leaf. A few upper marginal marks & blemishes. Very good copy overall of pleasing appearance. Early ownership inscription of one Johann Swallisch(?) (1488), & Pastor Nicolas Dehen (1687). Contemp blind tooled pigskin over bevelled wooden boards. Remains of hasps & clasp (one). Old label. Joints split on surface leather in one or two places. Rubbed else quite nice. *Not in D&M, though Kobergers famous bibles of similar dates are mentioned.*      **£8200/\$13940**
2. Latin Bible      “**Biblia**”. Thick Quarto. **1487-88**. Venice. George Arrivabenus. Gothic Type. Dated close of NT. Title leaf with single word ‘Biblia’. Leaves A2-8 reinforced at inner margins (NAT). Last leaf repaired in Margin (NAT). Good sized margins. Two short marginal tears. Occasional very light stains. A very good crisp, clean and virtually tear free copy. Initials in red and black. Later vellum backed boards. *Not in D & M. See Goff B 586; Proctor 4912; Hain 3099.*      **£5850/\$9945**
3. Latin Bible      “(**Biblia**)”. Thick Octavo. **1495**. Basle. Johannem Froben. 456 out of 508. Lacks quires AA8 & BB4 (12 leaves) & A-E8 (40 leaves). The former are part of the introduction before the text; the latter are the ‘Interpretationes’ after the text and final dated colophon. 64 lines to a page. Black Letter. Initials supplied in red and blue pen work. Some early marginal annotations on a few leaves. Few early leaves with some faded underscoring(?) Good sized margins. Main text is complete. Minor marks and very light browning else a very good copy. 18<sup>th</sup> cent calf backed boards. Joints sprung. Plain worn boards. Label. Provenance: Stonyhurst college with library stamp inside board etc. BL Cat 1A 37886. *This is Johannes Froben’s second Octavo Bible, following the above item.*      **£3300/\$5610**
4. Latin Bible      “**Biblia**”. Thick Small Folio. **1497**. (Strasburg). Johann Reinhard Gruninger. Gothic Letter. 489 leaves (of 492). Wants initial leaf \*1 (title leaf bearing single line ‘Biblia’) & last two leaves of Register at close. Side notes slightly shaved or cropped in a few places. Some neat 16<sup>th</sup> cent marginalia & annotations below colophon etc. 3-8 line initials supplied in red; similarly prelim leaves with initial strokes & paragraphs in red. First leaf or two with minor inner marginal wear, marks or on guards (NAT). Mainly an excellent crisp & mostly clean copy of very pleasing appearance. 19<sup>th</sup> cent purple morocco; gilt blocked. Decorated spine over raised bands. Lightly rubbed on the extremities else nice. *Not in D & M but see mention of same under D & M 6085. Copinger 27. Hain \*3122. BMC 1,111. Goff B-600.*      **£7500/\$12750**

5. **Tyndale Diglot NT** "The New Testament In English...With The Translation Of Erasmus In Latin". Tall Octavo. 1550. London. Thomas Gaultier for I.C. (John Cawood?) Black Letter Text. Pages not numbered. (528pp-text). Of the prelim. leaves present, only the title page & Epistel to the Reader are present here, in skilful facsimile in red & black. First leaf in Matthew in similar good facsimile. Possibly the final 2 table leaves at close also. One leaf in Mark repaired & remargined outer edge. Minor marks. Some outer marginal notes shaved or very slightly trimmed in places. Very good. 19<sup>th</sup> cent red grained morrocco. Blind line borders. Ownership book plate & signatures from 1917, Scarboro, UK. DMH 88. *4<sup>th</sup> Edition of Tyndales English New Testament, with Erasmus's Latin Translation added for good measure, in parallel columns. Quite scarce nowadays, & always sought after. N.B. This could have come from Francis Fry's collection, though nothing positively identifies it. The excellent facsimiles in red & black are very reminiscent of his productions on old paper. Also the 19<sup>th</sup> cent bindings are similar to what he had done. Finally, the book has come from a source of other of Francis Fry's books.* £11750/\$19975

6. **Great Bible** "The Byble". Small Thick Folio. (12x9x3"). 1549. London. Edward Whitchurch. Black Letter. With fine woodcut title pages to sections beginning with Joshua, Psalms and the New Testament. Different title to Apocrypha. Lacks the general title page and three of the six preliminary leaves called for. Also lacks the final leaves of the NT after 2 Timothy. Last signature is M7. (Should be 012). Fourteen leaves in Ezekiel with lower marginal worming and ordinary paper repairs there. Two leaves with some significant loss of text towards lower outer corners. A very few other leaves with minor corner repairs etc. Scattered water marks, more so in the NT. Some dusting or light browning. Overall a pleasing volume which is tear free in the main, and with adequate margins. Paper sturdy. Some scattered 17<sup>th</sup> century manuscript marginalia. 4pp of older notes at front of the bible. One leaf of 17<sup>th</sup> century notes in a neat hand reverse of last leaf of Malachi (which is a blank otherwise). 18<sup>th</sup> century calf. Finely rebacked over raised bands. Lettered. DMH 76. STC 2079. *Dore mentions that 'this edition of the Great Bible was intended to be a companion volume to the Reformation Prayer Book issued the same year, as it supplied the Psalms, which were not printed in that volume, as well as enabled the First and Second Lessons, and the Epistels and the Gospels. According to the new Calendar, to be read as directed by the table, which for the first time is headed 'The Table To Finde The Epistels & Gospels. Usually Read in the Church, according unto the booke of Common Prayer etc'* £6450/\$10965

7. **Great Bible** "The Bible". Folio. (1562). London. Ric.Harrison. Black Letter. General title in facsimile on old paper. Lacks all before Numbers 17. Ends at leaf '03' in NT (James 4). Present with NT title page, Lacking 1-2" of outer edge, not affecting text block. Wants 4 leaf gathering in Apocrypha. A score of leaves with minor or substantial tears, occasionally with loss of text. Contents shaken. Sewing slack. Fore-edges worn and a bit crumbly as NT proceeds. Mainly clear of text block. Lower outer corner thumbing and wear. Some stains and browning etc. Sound to quite good in large sections. Contemporary boards with leather lost. Late 17<sup>th</sup> century ownership inscriptions of one Richard Harrison - same name as printer. DMH 117. *The republishing of the Great Bible after the accession of Queen Elizabeth. Harrison was fined for printing this edition without License.* £2900/\$4930

8. **Great Bible** "The Bible". Very Thick Quarto. (1569),69. London. John Cawood. Lacks the general title page and next seven intro leaves out of the 24. Begins with Book of Common Prayer which is integral to the Bible (16 pages). Thereafter textually complete with title pages to Joshua, Psalms, Apocrypha and New Testament. The NT engraved title is a little rubbed in places with outer corner loss in frame (2x2") (NAT). Black Letter. One leaf in Peter with some outer marginal loss, just into scripture references. Later wear and damp marks in the Revelation, with a final patch of upper inner gutter worming at close. Final two table leaves slightly reduced round edge (NAT). Half a dozen leaves with inconsequential flaws or small tears (NAT). Lightly browned in places. Random damp marks. A very good copy with negligible wear, tear or defects. Good margins. Thick Paper. Early full reversed calf. Green calf label. Good binding. Ex Libris owner, circa 1917. DMH 127a. *The first of three variant editions of the Great Bible of this year. This is the last year in which this edition was printed.* £3950/\$6715

Some early deep gutter staining. Scattered light water marks. A very good sturdy copy complete and in mainly clean condition. Contemporary blind tooled calf over wooden boards. Hasps and clasps lost. Rebacked over raised bands to match the first volume. DMH 72. *The English Version of the influential Latin Paraphrase or Commentary of Erasmus on the New Testament, accompanied by the Text of the Great Bible Version. The injunctions of Edward VI ordered that a copy of this book should be placed in every parish church. Due to the often inclement conditions of such churches in those days...coupled with the wear and tear of public use, it is uncommon to find complete copies, let alone very good copies like those above. Lacks the title page. Also leaves Z2, Z7, 2A3-6; 2D1 & 2E1 in the main text. Also lacks final two leaves in the table at close. One page remaining. Few minor tears or blemishes. A bit browned. Some early upper headlines shaved or cropped. Outer upper corner chapter numbers also shaved or cropped in places. A few side notes shaved. Mainly a good copy. Contemp calf. Small metal diamond center piece. 4 remaining metal corner pieces. Rebacked in 19<sup>th</sup> cent. Worn at extremities & joints. Quite good. NOT IN DMH. See STC 2887.7 (& comparison with similar edition of 2879.8). *Very scarce New Testament. Only the Lambeth Palace copy in the UK & NY Public Library copy abroad & that imperfect.* **£1950/\$3305**

The New Testament had surfaced in 1582, and the long delay in publishing the OT was, according to the preface ‘because of our poor estate in banishment’..The marginal annotations are ‘less vehement’ than those of the NT, and also less copious. The translation is said ‘to have been conferred with, and conformed’ to ‘the most perfect Latin Edition’ (1592).* **£990/\$1683**
