What does the Occupational Health Surveillance Assessment cover?

- Eyesight to Occupational Health Standard plus colour blindness & peripheral vision
- Hearing Test using the very latest mobile Siemens equipment
- Lung Function Test using a digital spirometer
- Skin Surveillance using a BIA Skin monitor
- Hand Arm Vibration Syndrome Surveillance
- Musculo-skeletal Assessment
- Urinalysis for Protein, Glucose and Blood (optional)
- Review of medication
- Occupational Health Questionnaire

How do the assessments work?

- The assessments will be conducted within a private room at your premises by a trained Occupational Health practitioner qualified to diploma level
- The assessments will last 20 minutes
- The employee will be advised of their results during the assessment and report will be sent to the organisations Health and Safety Manager within 14 days

Why is the Occupational Health Surveillance Assessment beneficial to you?

Results confirm the vast majority of participants will have very positive screening assessments. In some cases, participants are advised of issues that need to be addressed but corrected early, could improve future results.

Actionally, the assessment will allow participants to discuss with the practitioner any changes to the workplace that will help maintain good health or improve future health.

Note: The assessments can be amended to meet your specific requirements and qualify for Night Worker, Fork Lift Driver and Working at Height certifications to name a few!
