Birmingham City Mission is a Christian charity established in 1966. It has a holistic ministry – to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the city centre and the community, and to express God's love through many

caring projects, bringing practical help to thousands of people in Birmingham and its suburbs.



In this rapidly changing social environment we intend, with God's help, to continue this important task of reaching the unreached for Christ and bringing comfort, care and hope to the needy and marginalised.

Birmingham has a population of over 1 million, with a total of more than 3 million in the West Midlands. It is a city of rich diversity in language, background and culture. Birmingham City Mission strives to help and support all those in need

through a wide variety of projects. These include work with the homeless, those in poverty, the elderly and children & young people.



### How your money will help

John's story

For 10 years I was a heroin addict. I moved into Birmingham City Mission, I was homeless. I managed to get myself off drugs and started helping out at the Resource Centre volunteering. Eventually I got given my own flat. All my furniture came from the City Mission.

### Each year...

- 35 disadvantaged young people taken on Camp
- 1,100 home visits to shut-in elderly
- 2,000 food parcels given out
- Nearly 2,000 meals served to the homeless and vulnerable
- · Over 100 primary schools visited by the Children's Team
- Over 1,000 families in need receive Christmas presents



Think about whether your event could be harmful in any way and how you can minimise risk to ensure the safety of everyone involved. There may be need of first aiders, or supervision & guidance from the emergency services. Birmingham City Mission cannot accept any responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage a result of your event so, particularly for larger events, please check that you have adequate insurance to protect yourself as well as your guests.

You can set up your own sponsorship page on www.btplc.com/mydonate in support of BCM. This lets people know about your sponsored event and makes it easy for them to give online.

# giftaid it

Please ask your supporters to tick the box for Gift Aid on your sponsorship form if they are UK taxpayers. We also need their postcode to be able to claim tax back. Reclaiming Gift Aid can make a big difference to the total amount you raise.

### 3. Legal concerns

Make sure your event does not need any special licence or permission. You can talk to your local authority or police force for advice about this. We recommend you arrange a fundraising event rather than a collection as this requires a licence. All promotional materials should contain the words 'Birmingham City Mission is a registered charity number 1051023'.

How about telling the local press about your event?

Writing a simple press release is not difficult. Here are a few tips:

- Keep it short a maximum of one side of A4 with double spaced, typed text
- Give it an eye-catching title, with the most interesting information at the top in bold italics or capital letters
- Avoid long blocks of text use short paragraphs or bullet points
- Necessary information to include:
  - 1. Your name and contact details
  - 2. Date, time, place and purpose of the
  - 3. A brief introduction to Birmingham City Mission

Send your press release to local radio, newpapers and TV - they may well be interested in your event!
