



Travel and Accommodation

Parking at the John Radcliffe Hospital can be difficult, and we are keen to ensure that a minimum of vehicles come onto the hospital site. Therefore, the recommended hotels are selected with good transport links to the hospital in mind.

For those closest to the hospital:

A number of Bed and Breakfasts are available within a 10-20minute walk from the hospital, with parking. These tend to charge approx. £90 a night. Search for B&Bs in Headington. Bed and breakfasts in the Summertown area have good links to the hospital via the 700 bus route.

For those coming by road:

Ramada Oxford - Based at M40 Wheatley Services. Approx. £60 per night. Parking additional on site. This hotel has a bus link into Headington (Arriva Bus Route 280. Get off at Headington Shops stop- Approx. 7 min walk to Hospital). Also a short drive to Thornhill Park and Ride which has direct bus to the John Radcliffe Hospital (Bus 800).

Oxford Belfry - Q Hotels – Approx. £95 per night. Access to Park and Ride as outlined above for the Ramada

For those coming by train (or wanting city centre accommodation):

The city centre has a range of hotels at a variety of prices, which tend to be more expensive. The hospital is served by Bus route 13 or X13 which goes directly from the train station, through the city centre, and direct to the hospital.

The Royal Oxford Hotel - approx. £125 a night. Close proximity to rail station and bus stop.

Mercure Oxford Eastgate Hotel – approx. £150 a night. 20 min walk from train station, walkable to bus stop.
