

WHERE WE ARE



DRIVING

BY CAR APPROACHING MANCHESTER FROM THE NORTH

- From either the M61 or M66, join the M60 ring road taking the anti-clockwise direction (towards M62/Liverpool)
- Follow this round anti-clockwise until you get to junction 12 for the M602 to Salford
- After a couple of minutes down the M602, branch left at the roundabout, take the first exit onto the A5063, Albion way (the Toyota garage will be on your left).
- At the T-Junction, turn right onto the A6/Chapel Street/Salford Crescent.
- You will drive past Salford University on your left, School of Electronic Musicis a few hundred yards further down Chapel Street (situated in the square immediately after Salford Cathedral)
- You will need to turn left onto Ford Street to lead you to parking (see short-term parking).

APPROACHING MANCHESTER FROM THE SOUTH

- Leave the M6 Northbound via junction 21A and join the M62 Eastbound towards Manchester.
- The M62 motorway turns into the M602 towards Salford. After a couple of minutes down the M602, branch left, then at the roundabout take the first exit onto the A5063, Albion way (the Toyota garage will be on your left).
- At the T-Junction, turn right onto the A6/Chapel Street/Salford Crescent.
- You will drive past Salford University on your left, School of Electronic Music is a few hundred yards further down Chapel Street (situated in the square immediately after Salford Cathedral).
- You will need to turn left onto Ford Street to lead you to parking (see short-term parking).


APPROACHING MANCHESTER FROM THE EAST

- The M62 motorway from the East turns into the M60 Manchester ring road. Follow this round anti-clockwise until you get to junction 12 for the M602 to Salford.
- After a couple of minutes down the M602, branch left, then at the roundabout take the first exit onto the A5063, Albion way (the Toyota garage will be on your left).
- At the T-Junction, turn right onto the A6/Chapel Street/Salford Crescent.
- You will drive past Salford University on your left, School of Electronic Music is a few hundred yards further down Chapel Street (situated in the square immediately after Salford Cathedral)
- You will need to turn left onto Ford Street to lead you to parking (see short-term parking).

APPROACHING MANCHESTER FROM THE WEST

- The M62 motorway from Liverpool turns into the M602 towards Salford.
- After a couple of minutes down the M602, branch left, then at the roundabout take the first exit onto the A5063, Albion way (the Toyota garage will be on your left).
- At the T-Junction, turn right onto the A6/Chapel Street/Salford Crescent.
- You will drive past Salford University on your left, School of Electronic Music is a few hundred yards further down Chapel Street (situated in the square immediately after Salford Cathedral).
- You will need to turn left onto Ford Street to lead you to parking (see short-term parking).





BY TRAIN



SALFORD CENTRAL (CLOSEST TRAIN STATION)

- Exit left out of the station and walk up to Chapel Street
- When you reach Caribbean Flavas on your left hand side, turn left onto Chapel Street
- Walk down Chapel Street, and cross over Trinity Way.
- Bexley Square will be on your right hand side just before Salford Cathedral.
- School of Electronic Music is the large set of silver double doors, buzz 19 for Reception.



MANCHESTER VICTORIA (CLOSEST MAIN TRAIN STATION)

- Walk out of the main entrance of Victoria Station, onto Hunts Bank. Head downhill, the MEN arena should be on your right hand side.
- At the bottom of the hill, turn left onto Chapel Street.
- Walk all the way down, and cross over Trinity Way.
- Bexley Square will be on your right hand side just before Salford Cathedral.

BY BUS/FOOT



BY BUS

There is a bus stop right outside SEM. Use the **TFGM route planner** to plan your route and find the best bus service based on your location. The location to enter for SEM is 'Salford Cathedral'.

BY FOOT/BUS FROM PICCADILLY GARDENS:

- Head to Market Street (the main street with shops)
- Walk all the way down, this will turn into Blackfriars Street
- Turn left onto Chapel Street when you reach the 'Black Lion' pub on your left
- Walk all the way down, and cross over Trinity Way.
- Bexley Square will be on your right hand side just before Salford Cathedral.
