

## Fuel Surcharge – May 2019

The average UK pump price for diesel was 132.0 pence per litre during February 2019.

In accordance with our fuel surcharge policy, our fuel surcharge will therefore increase to 14.0% with effect from Tuesday, 14 May 2019.

Fuel surcharges have been necessary to cope with fluctuations in the price of diesel and whilst we appreciate that such charges are never welcome, we do try to ensure that our charges are competitive and transparent.

We use reliable, trusted sources such as the AA to establish average UK pump prices for fuel and update our website every month with the latest information and customers can also check which fuel surcharge level will apply based on the applicable average UK pump prices.
