Andrew Watts had Limousin heifers to 216.5 pkg and Danny Raven had steers to 223.5 pkg and heifers to 215.5pkg. Well finished R grade cattle regularly 200.5 from 191.5pkg. Traditional breeds 170.5 to 190.5 pkg depending on finish. Heavy cattle saw steers to $£ 1,385.74$ from Waterer Partners with heifers to $£ 1,176.76$ from Ben Whiting.
