

## What if my animal needs to stay with you?

Many critical patients will need overnight care. An emergency veterinarian and ICU technicians are with your pet overnight for continuous treatment and monitoring. Our priority is to return your pet to the care of your primary veterinarian. Continuous 24 hour emergency care is available at our hospital as needed.

## What are my financial responsibilities?

R.E.A.C.H. doctors and staff strive to keep you well informed regarding costs associated with caring for your pet. When you call we will discuss with you the best way to handle your emergency, as well as the exam fee. When you arrive at the hospital, a R.E.A.C.H. doctor will examine your pet and provide a medical care plan detailing costs associated with the best treatment for your pet's emergency.

If your companion animal stays with us, it will be necessary to leave a prepayment for your pet's care. If your pet receives treatment and goes home with you, the full balance will be due at the time of discharge. If you should need financial assistance, we offer Care Credit, a line of credit for health care needs, as a no interest payment plan. 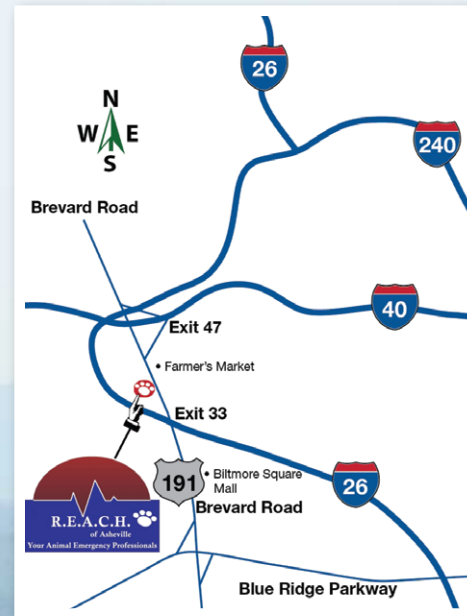

From I-240: Take Exit 1B. Follow Route 191 south (Brevard Road). R.E.A.C.H. is 1.7 miles on your right.
