


Notes for assembly:


- 1. For the best results, assemble the Expandastore on level ground so as to avoid bending of the chassis and complications with the aligning of the panels.
- 2. On initial assembly, only hand-tighten all nuts and bolts, when assembly is complete tighten all nuts and bolts with your socket spanner.
- 3. Prior to fitting the door panel, adjust the roller catch on the door to the fully 'in' position before closing (using a standard flat blade screwdriver) on the adjusting screw located on the roller catch. Once the store is fully assembled, the catch can be adjusted back out until the door close with ease.
- 4. Retain all parts if demounting.

Notes after assembly:


- 1. You can expand your Expandastore at any time by purchasing an additional unit and a linking kit, the Expandastore can be linked end to end and side to side.
- 2. You can return the Expandastore back to it's original flat pack form at any time.
- 3. Expandastore is not designed to be stacked when it is assembled.
- 4. You can lift the Expandastore by crane with a load of up to 1,500kg on board.
- 5. Oil the lock / hinges regularly.









d. Remove the spacer protective blocks (retain these for future use incase you want to return the store to its original flat-pack form).

When positioning door and wall panels make sure that the overlapped lip edge is at the top and the flat ledge is at the bottom.







Before moving onto stage 4 (roof fitting) you must adjust the self closer door catch. Turn the adjustment screw until the self closer catch is recessed as far as possible.

This is necessary, because if the catch remains unadjusted it can lock into position and is difficult to open if the roof has been fitted.


