### Signing In/Out Reminder

Please remember to sign your child/children in and out each day for Safeguarding as well as Fire and Safety reasons. Should you have a relative or childminder dropping off/collecting your child, please also remind them to ensure that they sign your child in/out.

#### **Academic Review Evenings**

We will be holding our next Parents' Academic Review Evenings from Monday 24th February to Thursday 5th March 2020 to give you the opportunity to come and look through your child's progression file and discuss their development with their key person. Appointment times will be available from 4.00pm to 5.45pm in 15min slots. The Review Appointment Chart will be posted on the Parents' Notice Board as of Monday 10th February. Please view and write your child's name next to your desired time slot.

Please note that Review Evenings are only held twice a year, and the reason behind this frequency is because a reasonable period of time is required to be able to observe and assess changes in patterns and behaviour. Parents are always welcome to make an appointment at any time to see their child's Key Person, Room Leader or the Manager if they wish to do so.

#### Are You Using Yours?

All children aged 0-30mths will each have their own communication books. In this book, details of your child's day (inclusive of activities, meals eaten, general well-being) will be recorded and the book made ready for your collection each day, therefore minimising time spent on verbal feedback during your collection time.

Do read through your child/ children's communication book in the evenings and write any comments that you wish to add, as it's very important that we hear from you too! You are very welcome to add any events that may take place whilst your child's not at nursery such as their first step / word or even how their weekend away went, a rough night, feeling poorly, etc. This communication book can be used to form a journal and a lovely keepsake if you wish, but do remember to return your communication book each time you bring your child to Nursery!

Please note this initiative is not to suggest that you cannot speak with your child's key person if you have any queries or concerns about your child, however, we desire to avoid queues and feelings of hecticness upon your arrival. We want your collection time to be a relaxed and enjoyable experience as possible.

## Tax-Free Childcare

Did you know you can get up to £500 every 3 months (£2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare? If you get Tax-Free Childcare, the government will pay £2 for every £8 you pay your childcare provider via an online account. You can use it to pay for approved childcare, and you can get Tax-Free Childcare at the same time as the 30hr Funding if you're eligible for both. MFN is signed up to Tax Free Childcare, so why not go on line now, and check your eligibility at: www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare

PSSST... Are you aware of the type of credit you are building on your Nursery account? Did you know that neither Childcare Voucher payments nor Tax-Free Childcare payments can be refunded back to you? These type of payments can only be refunded back to the organisation from whence the payment came and it will be your responsibility to contact that organisation to retrieve any refund that you are due...

#### MFN Birthday Cake Reminder

As there are a number of children with differing dietary requirements and allergies, we cannot receive or distribute cakes that are brought in by parents.

HOWEVER, MFN happily bakes birthday cakes on site so as to ensure that all children can partake of their peer's birthday celebration so a big HOORAY as the birthday fun continues (and at no extra cost to the parent!) Please let your child's Room Leader know if you do **NOT** want your child to have a birthday cake and/or a celebration.

# Sick children

As per our Sick Child Policy, if a child is unwell at the Nursery, the child's parent/carer will be contacted to collect the child immediately. Please remember that children should also be kept home for a minimum of 48 hours after vomiting or diarrhoea and 24hrs following the introduction of antibiotics (particularly as they could have a reaction to medication during this period). We thank you for your cooperation as we strive for the well-being of all your young ones in our care.

Admin Office Hours Reminder: Our Admin Office is open from: **8am - 3pm, Monday to Friday**. Email and telephone messages left after 3.00pm will not be picked up until the next day. In case of emergency, please contact the Nursery mobile on **07903 883 882** and leave a text or voicemail message for our Deputy Manager to pass on to the Room Staff.

# Safeguarding: Use of Toilets

Please remember that neither parents nor carers are permitted to use the Nursery toilets (unless in an emergency and in this case member of staff MUST be а informed prior to use). If a child needs to use the toilet (or have a changed) whilst being nappy dropped off or collected, parents/ carers are then required to ask a member of staff to carry out this Please understand task. these procedures are in place for the purpose of safeguarding each of our children.

# **Booking Extra Sessions?**

If you need to book any extra days or any extra sessions, you will need to complete a booking form which can be found on the Parents Notice Boards, as well as on the "Nursery Fees" page on our website.

Spaces tend to be limited, so we encourage you to book early. Please note that once we have confirmed your booking, full payment of the extra sessions/days are to be made within seven days. Once confirmed, there are no refunds issued for cancellations or absence of any sort. Pre-booked days cannot be swapped.

In case of emergency please text or leave a voicemail on **07903 883 882** and we will get back to you to confirm whether your child is able to attend as quickly as possible.
