The Directors of Amano, Paul Wood and Graham Coiley have said: *"We have made the business decision to discontinue DSA equipment supply, and to concentrate our efforts on developing further our NMH services to students at HE institutions in the South West, and continuing to provide Assistive Tech student training and AT services to Universities and Colleges across the UK. We reluctantly make this decision but certain factors have led to us finding that this part of disabled student support is no longer sustainable.
