Notice and Collection

Choice and Consent

Prior to obtaining your consent, Trinity Marinas Ltd will describe the choices available to you and obtain implicit or explicit consent with respect to the collection, use, and disclosure of your personal information, except in certain situations otherwise permitted by the law. Where it is reasonable to do so, we may rely on your implied consent. Otherwise, we will rely on explicit consent received directly from you to collect or use your personal information, for example, the collection of your personal information if you subscribe to a newsletter on the Site.

Use and Retention

Personal information provided to us by users is primarily stored on servers in The United Kingdom.

Trinity Marinas Ltd will erase personal information that is no longer needed.

Disclosure to Third Parties

Trinity Marinas Ltd does not transfer personal information to third parties or service providers.

Access

Trinity Marinas Ltd provides individuals with access to their personal information for review or update.
