How do you become the club champion:

At Aquavision we have two types of competition and grading, recreational and competitive. You can enter both recreational and competitive competitions and taking grading examinations in both. However you can only enter either recreational or competitive sessions in the club championship. You can enter the competitive session on the club championships once you have passed a National Skill Level. If this skill level is passed by the individual they will become a competitive swimmer. These swimmers are scored throughout the year in accordance with the points system is shown below:

10 points - For achieving a gold medal or competing in the Multi Regional or Club Championships. 7 points - Achieving a silver medal.

5 points - Achieving a Bronze medal.

At the end of the year the swimmer with the most points will become club champion.

Recreational Championships are via a competition on the 14th July 2013, all swimmer who have not done a National Grading can enter.
