

Victorian House Conversion – From Damp Cellar To Stylish Homes

A Manchester property developer used Cellarcote to convert the cellar of a Victorian house into flats.

The four storey house was going to be converted into ten flats but when the developer realised that he could use Cellarcote to waterproof the damp cellar quickly and easily he decided to convert the extensive cellar into flats too – giving him space for an extra four flats.

The waterproofing of the cellar was carried out by local builders who sandblasted the walls to create smooth, sound surfaces. They then applied Cellarcote to the walls and floor. The walls were plastered using a dab and board system and the plaster was painted over. Electrics were fitted in back boxes that were attached to the drylining.

The whole waterproofing job only took two days.
