<b>Location</b>	Bowlees Visitor Centre and surrounding area

<b>Purpose of role</b>	To help with educational visits, events at the centre and to staff the information desk and gift shop.
<b>Description of tasks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Schools come to Bowlees and the surrounding area on educational visits. Volunteers are needed to help support the pupils on these visits. The visits usually involve guided walks and outdoor activities.</li><li>• A series of family events are held at the visitor centre each year. Volunteers are needed to help staff these events and run craft activities for families.</li><li>• Volunteers are also needed to help staff the information centre and gift shop, duties will involve cash handling, staffing the till and providing information to the general public.</li></ul>

<b>Time commitment</b>	School visits usually run between 9.30am and 3.00pm and volunteers are asked to stay for the whole session. Time commitment with regard to staffing events and staffing the information centre is much more flexible and can be arranged to suit the individual volunteer.
<b>Skills and Qualifications</b>	Volunteers will be enthusiastic, friendly and enjoy working with people of all ages. Experience of leading/assisting with art/craft/wildlife/biodiversity activities would be an advantage but isn't essential. Experience of working in a customer facing environment would be an advantage but is not essential.
<b>Training and Support</b>	All volunteers will receive induction training. On-going training and support will be offered to all volunteers as the opportunity arises.
<b>Reimbursement of Expenses</b>	Out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed: Mileage costs @40p per mile or the cost incurred in using public transport.
<b>Benefits of Volunteering</b>	Join a friendly team, meet people, gain experience/new skills and learn more about the North Pennines AONB.
