Nicolas Catena Zapata Cabernet Sauvignon/Malbec 2013 150cl

Nicolás Catena Zapata has an intense dark violet color with blue-black tones. A complex wine with delicate aromas of black cherry and licorice, it is enlivened by minerals, violet, spice, and herbs. The palate is sharply delineated and impressively concentrated, with a serious backbone supporting its very fresh currant and mineral flavors.

The inaugural 1997 vintage of this Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec blend set a new standard of quality for wines from South America when it won a series of blind tastings against other prestigious cuvées from around the world. Nicolás Catena Zapata is made from a plant-by-plant selection of historic rows in the Catena Zapata vineyards.

The wine is made from over 200 separate microvinifications representing different rows, altitudes, and harvest times. The wine is aged in French oak barrels for 18 months. It is only produced in outstanding vintage years.

Barolo Castiglione Vietti 2013 150cl

The grapes are selected from small vineyards in Castiglione Falletto, Monforte, Barolo, Novello; the vines are between 7 and 40 years old, planted in a clay-limestone soil. Plants are trained with guyot method, with an average density of roughly 4800 units per hectare. All the different crus are vinified and aged separately with slightly different processes to underline the singular characteristics of each parcel and terroir. Fermentation occurs in stainless steel with daily cap submersion for extraction of flavour and colour.

The wine is aged for 24-30 months in oak and then all parcels are carefully blended before bottling.

Beautiful glowing ruby. Fine earthy nose, but right now quite backward. Succulent palate with a powerful tannic structure. Really long and a little vibrant. Firm, long red-fruit finish

1999 Chateau Leoville Barton, Saint-Julien, France 150cl

Whenever Bordeaux is criticised for its price rises or lack of understanding of customer needs there is one name that is always excepted: Anthony Barton. Not only are his wines always very fairly priced, but at their best they rival the quality of the First Growths.

Deep plummy/blackcurrant nose. Pure. Good structure/tannins. Ripe sweet black cherry fruit. Stylish wine, wonderful integration and smoothness. Divine. A perfumed red-berried nose. The oak is still quite pronounced, very sweet and vanillary.

The palate is medium-bodied, dominated by the Cabernet with well-integrated oak. Smooth and seductive.sturdy tannins, a little pepper again on the entry with very good structure on the mid-palate. Quite foursquare and "correct" with an edgy, off-dry, very "Saint Julien" finish. Very fine – very...English! Drink now-

2010 Chateau Fourcas-Hosten, Listrac-Medoc, France 150cl

Blend of two complementary terroirs (clay-limestone, Pyrenean gravel) Château Fourcas Hosten offers the gourmet balance of a crunchy fruit on the attack and a complex mouth with a velvety texture. An elegant and racy tannic texture brings a lot of finesse to the finish.

The Fourcas-Hosten 2010 has an attractive bouquet with blackberry, warm gravel and cedar scents that are nicely defined. The palate is medium-bodied with plenty of supple black fruit on the entry, nicely judged acidity and a pleasing rounded finish with good weight and structure.

2014 Jean-Luc & Eric Burguet Gevrey-Chambertin Mes Favorites Vieilles Vignes, Cote de Nuits, France 150cl

This cuvée is made from older vines in their favourite sites

The 2014 Gevrey Chambertin Mes Favorites Vieilles Vignes has a modest nose with slightly smudged, quite earthy red berry fruit. The wine displays a dense purple colour, with rich raspberry fruit; new barrels providing a bit more stuffing. The palate is crisp on the entry, building gently in the mouth with hints of blood orange and black pepper towards the nicely structured, almost conservative finish. A decent Gevrey, if not one of my own favorites. This is really singing!
