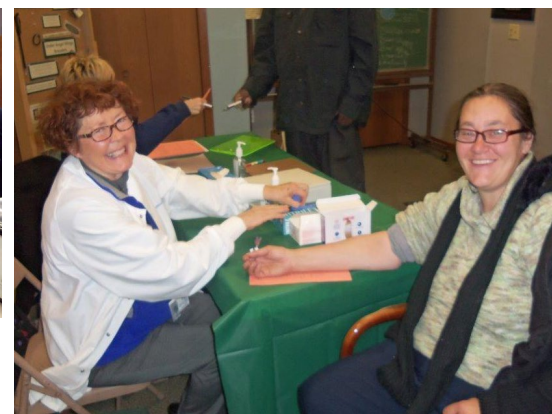
### CYCLES FOR CHANGE
