ABOUT THE SERVICE

Foundations to Employment is a new service being offered by the Cyrenians Learning and Work team. The service supports people facing complex barriers and multiple issues which can include:

- A history of offending
- A history of substance misuse
- Low social skills
- A lack of self-management
- Low self-esteem or lack of confidence
- Poor literacy or numeracy skills

All of these can have a major impact on people's journey towards employment.

BLIC LIBRARY

The service aims to help people to remove or negotiate through their barriers so that they are ready to move into vocational training or volunteering.

The service uses the Good Life Model, a holistic approach to personal development which looks to enact permanent positive change by giving people a firm foundation upon which to build so that they feel that they have a great more to gain, resulting in a significantly reduced temptation to repeat negative behaviours.
