



A Night for Nepal

In 2011, Property Frontiers CEO, Ray Withers, along with fellow trustee Charlotte Ashton founded the Frontiers Foundation, a not-for-profit UK registered charity committed to supporting grassroots community projects around the world.

Two years on, the Frontiers Foundation has raised a staggering £20,000 enabling the charity to drill a borehole in Zambia, rebuild and support an orphanage in Kenya and provide funding for a young person's community project in the favelas of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

Now, as the charity enters its third year of operation, the Frontiers Foundation trustees are delighted to announce their fourth project – supporting the MondoChallenge Foundation and their work with schoolchildren in Nepal.

Namaste from Nepal

The Frontiers Foundation first learned about the MondoChallenge Foundation through their charitable works in Africa and was very impressed by their sustainable education projects across more than 15 remote village communities across Nepal.

Investing in better education in order to give Nepalese children a brighter future is a real challenge in remote, mountainous regions which is why the MondoChallenge Foundation together with the Frontiers Foundation are committed to taking schools, teachers and equipment to these logistically disadvantaged children in their local communities.

Already the MondoChallenge has funded 15 new classrooms, 11 teachers, 22 student sponsorships as well as setting up libraries, music and science labs, providing games equipment and safe drinking water supplies. Over 1,500 Nepalese children of all ages are benefiting from the MondoChallenge Foundation's good work.

Every child deserves an education – let's give them that opportunity



A shortage of funding for teachers, school buildings, educational supplies and even basic resources such as drinking water means that almost half, many girls, receive no formal education.


With these needs in mind and bricks and mortar at our hearts, the **Frontiers Foundation is committed to raising £10,000** to fund:
