


WHOWEARE

Royal West Academy is **public high school** within the EMSB that operates under Section 240 of the Education Act. This classification permits RWA to select students without regard to school of origin, as long as the candidate has a Certificate of Eligibility for English instruction.

Royal West Academy specializes in teaching motivated students who want an enriched curriculum.

ORIGIN OF ROYAL WEST ACADEMY STUDENTS

Our students come to RWA from approximately 30 schools.



School fees are below \$200 for the year

(subject to change by the RWA Governing Board)

This includes course materials, a Student Agenda, a Student Calendar and a large part of the ECA program. Additional fees for opportunities like overnight trips may apply if your child chooses to participate.

Students complete three ECAs from four ECA categories annually. This gives all students a chance to take risks, find enrichment, and experience new things outside the regular classroom:

- <u>environment</u>
- sport



Essential Characteristics:

- Motivated and conscientious
- Open to trying new and exciting things
- Enjoy working collaboratively toward a common goal
- Accepting of differences and open to exploring diversity in all its forms



PROCEDURE/CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Royal West Academy attracts more applicants than it can accept. The selection process established by the school is as follows:

- On-time applications to the school are considered first.
- Applications are accepted from any student eligible for English language education.
- All applicants, regardless of school of origin, are treated equally.

QUALIFYING TESTS

- Applicants for Secondary I write tests for English, French, and Math
 - 45 minutes each
 - all multiple-choice
 - Math qualifying test is offered in both English & French
- Applicants must bring:
 - 2-HB pencils a snack

- an eraser
- a book to read
- no calculator or cell phone is permitted
- There is no additional penalty for wrong answers.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

- All applications must be accompanied by previous school records.
- The cumulative **Grade 5 report** (June 2022) is particularly important.

UPDATES TO APPLICATION STATUS

Based on the results of the Qualifying Tests and the Report Cards, applicants will be notified in October by letter of:

- an offer of early acceptance
 - OR
- the date and time of their interview
 OR
- our inability to offer placement.

If your child's address is outside of the territory of the **English Montreal School Board**, then you must apply for an

INTER-BOARD AGREEMENT

from your local school board (e.g. Lester B.
Pearson School Board, etc.) to enroll at
Royal West Academy.
Please contact your local school board for
additional information on this procedure.
You are asked to wait until acceptance is
confirmed before making the request
for an inter-board agreement.

INTERVIEWS

- ~ 300 applicants are interviewed with their parent/guardian
- help determine willingness to participate in all aspects school life.



Post-Interview

 Our selection committee reviews the interview report (prepared by retired RWA staff), and all submitted documents, to make the final decision concerning each applicant.



By December, all letters (acceptance, wait list, or refusal) will be sent to all applicants who have been interviewed.

Wait list candidates will be notified at a later date if, and when, they can be accommodated.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Results of Qualifying Tests are kept strictly confidential.
- Interviews start as soon as possible and run through November.
- You will be notified of any other factors that may affect your child's application to Royal West Academy.
