They taught children in Ambalavao how the power of soap and water can help them lead happier, healthier lives.



"We teamed up with local girl scouts to play games and sing songs with children, making learning about hygiene fun. Adults can find it hard to change habits, but children are eager to learn. Children help the whole community become healthier – they're not too shy to spread the word about using soap and clean water to stop illnesses like diarrhoea."

1st Bromborough Guides did the RSPB "Big Garden Birdwatch" at the Hadlow wildlife garden. They logged 10 types of bird (and squirrels!). The numbers given are the maximum number of that species seen at any one time: Blue Tit 2, Blackbird 2, Robin 2 (one tried to fight off anything else that came near the food!), Chaffinch 1, Wood pigeon 2, Great tit 3, Long tailed tit 2, Magpie 1, Coal tit 1, and the star of the show, a beautiful pheasant, making the garden his own.
